Dear Parish Family,

Fr Vijay sends his love and prayers and is safely arrived back at his parish in India. Meanwhile we welcome back Fr. Raja who will be with us until the end of August. We are very grateful for their help - even in summer there is so much to do. We are blessed with large numbers of daily penitents in Confession, and St. Clare's has been needing our assistance on weekends. Thank you for welcoming him back. Again he will be offering for us a Scripture Study series, this time on the Parables of Jesus. Fr. Raja received an advanced scripture degree from Rome and taught at the seminary for 16 years, so we are blessed to have his expertise! Fr. Raja's series on the Parables will be on Tuesday nights in Rooms 4/5 beneath the Hall from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm, from July 22 to August 26. Plan to attend!

Thank you for your support last week of the second collection for Together in Mission. We are grateful to the 414 households who made pledges of \$115,627 towards our goal of \$197,013. We have received \$80,604 so far and need \$116,408 more to reach our goal which is due in November. Together in Mission is a vital program that directly assists parishes in our own Archdiocese, particularly in the inner city, who cannot sustain themselves on their own as we do. The funds collected go directly to these parishes so they can continue to offer basic services and ministry in their challenged neighborhoods. Thanks for your help and generosity and I invite anyone who is able to, to consider a special gift to Together in Mission. You can make a gift here in the office or at the collection at Mass, or if needed feel free to contact me directly.

Tomorrow evening, Monday July 14, is our celebration of our patroness, Saint Kateri Tekakwitha! All are invited to our special Mass beginning with Prayer and Procession at 6:30 pm and Mass at 7:00 pm. This past year some priest friends visited her tomb and shrine outside Montreal and sent me photos. There is also a shrine in New York — check out the shrine's website at katerishrine.org. It is amazing that having died at the age of 24, her short life left such an impact of holiness, inspiring others by her perseverance and sacrifice in the face of so much opposition and adversity. Her last words were "I love you, Jesus!" May we emulate her heroic virtue and devotion in our own lives as we frequently turn to our patroness for her intercession, for our parish and for ourselves.

Sometimes our deacons and priests arrive on Sunday to find all the reserved parking spots for clergy taken. Some arriving late may think "Well, the priest is already here". Please if possible respect these parking spaces. Even at our most crowded 10:30 am Mass there are spaces available in the back corner. We recognize some may feel they need the clergy space because they can't walk that far. Let your conscience be your guide. When I've had to park in the back I just think, "Well, I need the steps!" We are looking at the issue of increasing handicapped parking spaces.






