



- Saint Kateri is known as the Lily of the Mohawks.
- Saint Kateri was born in 1656 in what is now New York.
- Her name, Tekakwitha meant "she who bumps into things" in Mohawk; she had poor eyesight.
- Tekakwitha became a Catholic on Easter Sunday in 1675, she received the name, Catherine, in Mohawk—Kateri.
- Pope Benedict the XVI canonized her on October 21, 2021—making her the first canonized Native American.
- We just celebrated her Feast Day on July 14th.






