

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday's readings are very much linked together in guiding us towards our proper priority in life: love of the Lord and others. Our First Reading can strike us as rather pessimistic: all is Vanity! In the end what is the point of it all? Ecclesiastes acknowledges ultimately we must leave everything behind. As bleak as this sounds, the author's point is that we should not work just for worldly recognition which is pointless in the big picture. So what is life for then? St. Paul provides the answer in our Second Reading: you were raised with Christ so seek what is above, not of what is on earth.

These messages lead perfectly into the message of Jesus. Most of us in our society of abundance, myself included!, have accumulated some amount of material possessions and some perhaps have savings -- "so many good things stored up for many years!" as the rich man in the parable says. These things are not wrong in themselves. The farmer was a smart and hard - working man who built up his wealth honestly. But he was too focused on it and didn't see it in the proper perspective of the brief fleeting nature of our lives described in the First Reading. It's fine to be responsible and care for our needs and our families; we need certain material things and we need to care for our families and save for the future. But because we will go on to the next life of Eternity at any moment, these things should not be our main focus or overwhelm us. We don't want the fate describe in Ecclesiastes: "All his days sorrow and grief are his occupation; even at night his mind is not at rest". The stock market, real estate, and gold prices go up and down, currencies can crash, but God's love for us is fixed and strong, permanent and never-changing, unlike the treasure of the world. He simply asks us to make love and devotion to Him and loving Him present in others to be our main concern. Since we'll leave the things of the world behind one day, these must be more in the background of our lives, just necessary things that we need and use temporarily as we make our journey, to the same destination but on different schedules, to the Lord.






