



HIGHLIGHT OF THE WEEK

NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In the Fall of 2021, the U.S. bishops approved a unique three-year eucharistic revival that aimed to foster a deeper devotion and knowledge about the Eucharist. The revival officially began on the feast of Corpus Christi on June 16, 2022, and will culminate with the National Eucharistic Congress 2024 in Indianapolis. Bishop Andrew Cozzens, an auxiliary bishop of Saint Paul and Minneapolis and chair of the bishops' evangelization committee, presented the plan to his fellow bishops by using the statement, "We want to start a fire, not a program."

The development of the plan was spurred by a 2019 Pew Research study, the results were shocking and suggested that only about one-third of U.S. Catholics believe the Church's teaching that the Eucharist is truly the body and blood of Christ.

The three-year Eucharistic Revival program includes three tiers: parish, diocesan, and national. In July of 2022, dioceses across the country were encouraged to hold Eucharistic events and make the Eucharist a primary focus. Following that, in July 2023, parishes will be encouraged to do the same. The revival will culminate in the summer of 2024 with a Eucharistic celebration event, held in a major city, that will serve as a pilgrimage site; therefore, keep your calendars open for July 17-21, 2024 in Indianapolis, Indiana.


