



Committee Reports

Board of Ed

Traci gave her report about her first year as coordinator. Some activities students were involved in include receiving First Reconciliation, contributing to a Mitten Tree, attending Ash Wednesday Mass, and attending Mass server training led by Dan Gray. On March 14, the Diocese suspended all classes due to COVID-19. First Communion was postponed until June 28, and Confirmation was postponed until September 27.

Youth Ministry

Patty reported on the events the Youth Ministry kids participated in during the
past year, including a mission trip to New Mexico, helping at the Knights of
Columbus Golf Outing, pumpkin decorating, Make a Difference Day, Community
Thanksgiving meal, a potato bake, Mother's Day flower sales, and a brat fry.

Social Concerns

 Deb gave the report on behalf of Joan Chizek. The blood pressure clinic was working well the third Sunday of every month, averaging 6 participants each time. Last year the Mitten Tree was donated to the Maribel Community Cupboard.

Finance Council

Deb gave the report on behalf of Chairperson Rick Knoflicek. Our parish moved forward with the updates in video and sound systems with the live streaming of mass and the installation of the hearing loop. These updates were funded by restricted funds, donations, and grants. This year, we reached our goal for the Bishop's Appeal. Our fundraisers did well this year. Brian and Dawn Rabas are planning a Valentine Dance at Gathering 43 on February 13, 2021. The annual raffle will be held at this event.

Maintenance Committee

John Heiser reported on the meeting from September 29. The caulking of the church and rectory looks good. Belinski has been chosen to plow the parking lot this winter and Darryl Johanek will shovel and salt the sidewalks. The shrub trimming and flower bed cleanup is usually done by the Youth Ministry on Make a Difference Day. If they can't do it, Darrel and other volunteers will. John also gave a list of updates that could be done to the church in future years.

Worship Committee

• Dan Gray reported on the accomplishments of the Worship Committee in the past year and the changes that were made due to the pandemic. Examples of this include scheduling priests while Fr. Santy was on vacation and in quarantine, obtaining a license for music to be live streamed as well as the equipment needed, installing protective shields for the choir, upstairs, and confessional areas, and purchasing disinfectant. Renee Swetlik joined the committee and is coordinator of mass servers.

Jean Schlies presented the two versions of the new mission statement. Version 1
is the popular decision, we will continue to develop it so it is more connected to
the Diocese statement and the Holy Sacraments.
