St. Joseph Annual Meeting took place on Sunday, November 10, 2019 in the parish hall following the 10:00 am Mass.

Cathie Lodel led the meeting to order at 11:30 AM.

Father Santy led us in an opening prayer.

Cathie Lodel welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order with the purpose to review July 1 2018 – June 30, 2019.

#### Cathie's opening remarks:

- This meeting is focused on FY from 7/1/2018 6/30/2019
- This has been a year of change (Sister Geri retiring, Father Maurice moving on, interim leaders and new leader; Father Santy) and thanked all who helped with the transitions.
- Recognized Pat Siehr for her service setting up sacristy for Masses. New team will rotate on monthly basis.
- Asked for more volunteers to support added Saturday Mass.

#### Father Santy's opening remarks:

- Thanked all for supporting him in his transition to his new role
- Recognized that there are many active members of St. Joseph's Parish and expressed admiration for how Parish member work together.
- Promised to do his best to perform his duties.
- · Asked that parishioners give him feedback

Cathie walked through the non-financial contents in the annual report and requested everyone please read and review the minutes from last year's meeting. She then asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Motion was made, seconded and not opposed so notes were approved as written.

Raquel then reviewed the Financial reports for the Parish and Parish Cemetery. Raquel asked that questions be held until after her report and various committee updates.

Representatives from the following committees were present to share an update:

- Cemetery:
- New fees and rules will be implemented in 2020 to get St. Joseph's Cemetery more in line with other local Parish Cemeteries.
- Plot price increases are also required to keep perpetual care promise solvent.

#### Cathie opened the meeting for questions and comments:

- What goes into the miscellaneous income line on report?
  - Smaller things like votive candle and Living Faith Book donations that would not be practical to break out in financial documents
- What is St. Joseph's reimbursement share for shared expenses?
  - o 35% when sharing with St James

- o 18% when sharing with Circle of Faith
- What is line for Bank Fees for?
  - Denmark State Bank account charges (\$45/month)
- Explain discrepancy in investment income from
  - Will need more detail as reports are more general
- Will SJ be required to support new Catholic grade school planned for Manitowoc?
  - Assessment comes from diocese. We currently support Roncalli and other grade schools.
     Not our decision to make.
- Can activities such as Church Time be included with Saturday Masses?
  - o Yes, in time as we gain attendance at our Masses. We need more volunteers.
- Why was there a discrepancy in bulletin regarding second collection this week? Maintenance v. active military
  - Miscommunication. Should not happen going forward.
- What happens to periodic donations that are intended to be used for specific projects like remodel bathrooms?
  - They go into general maintenance fund. Cannot earmark for projects until projects have been quoted on and approved by Pastoral Council and Finance Council.
- Are we getting new parishioners?
  - Yes and new Baptisms. Need to do better job introducing new members.

**MARRIAGE** 

Religious Education: A program of formal classes for all school age children. These sessions are held during the school year to provide basic knowledge of the faith and to encourage children to embrace our Christian values as well as worship with the parish faith community. Special emphasis is placed on preparation for the sacraments of Holy Eucharist. Reconciliation and Confirmation.

All school-age children are expected to participate in these classes throughout elementary and high school years. The parish and parents are partners in forming the faith-life of the children of St Joseph's - a very important part of the parish mission.

Marriage Preparation: All couples requesting a wedding at St Joseph are required to participate in a program of preparation for the sacrament of marriage. Information, initial preparation and counseling sessions constitute this program at the parish level. Each couple will also attend a session sponsored by the diocese. The church is extremely concerned that couples be well-prepared for marriage --not just for the wedding. We urge couples to create a family that is faith-filled and strengthened by participation in parish life. Couples wishing to be married at St Joseph should call the office at least six months prior to the anticipated date.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is a process by which people become members of the church, help people return or prepare for Confirmation as adults. The initial stage is a period of inquiry and getting acquainted with the Catholic church. These candidates will usually receive the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil.
