Advent



Dec. 3 - 1st Sunday in Advent - Hope This Sunday marks the beginning of the Advent season, and it focuses on the hope of the coming Messiah, anticipating the birth of Jesus Christ.

Dec. 10 - 2nd Sunday in Advent - Peace This Sunday emphasizes the theme of peace, reflecting on the tranquility that Christ's arrival brings to the world.

Dec. 17 - 3rd Sunday in Advent - Joy Often called Gaudete Sunday, it symbolizes joy and rejoicing in the imminent arrival of Jesus. The candle lit on this day is typically pink.

Dec. 24 - 4th Sunday in Advent - Love This Sunday underscores the love of God and the love we should share with one another. It prepares believers for the celebration of the birth of Jesus on Christmas.
