### Cemetery Reminder

Please remember to help us maintain cemetery plots for your loved ones. In order to limit the mowing time (difficulty and cost), and to ensure safety and prevent damage, here are the decoration rules for St. Joseph's Cemetery. Thank you for helping us keep our cemetery beautiful and serene.



- \* The area for decorations is limited to the width of the concrete base x 18 inches
- \* No Plastic or metal borders only concrete blocks with flat tops, flush with ground level.
- \* No stone, lava rock ground cover only wood chip cover
- \* No trees, shrubs, bushes or flower pots
- \* Sheppard's hooks must be placed adjacent to concrete base in front of headstone
- \* Solar lights must be placed adjacent to concrete base in front of headstone.
