

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Second Sunday of Lent

In the Lenten season, the Gospel of Mark 9:2-10 beckons us to journey with Jesus to the mountaintop where the Transfiguration unfolds. This divine encounter, veiled in mystery, offers insights for our spiritual reflections during this penitential season.

As Jesus is transfigured before Peter, James, and John, his garments become dazzling white, and Elijah and Moses appear, conversing with him. This heavenly manifestation unveils the divinity of Christ, a glimpse of the glory that awaits beyond the challenges of earthly existence. Lent invites us to ascend our own metaphorical mountains, seeking mo-

ments of divine encounter amid the rigors of self-reflection and repentance. Peter's response, desiring to build dwellings for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah, reflects the human inclination to cling to extraordinary moments. Yet, the divine voice interrupts, affirming Jesus as the Beloved Son and urging the disciples to listen to him. In our Lenten reflections, we are reminded not to become fixated on extraordinary experiences but to heed the continuous call of Jesus, directing us towards a life of discipleship and obedience.

Descending the mountain, Jesus instructs the disciples to keep silent about the vision until after the resurrection. This Lenten revelation invites us to embrace a certain interior silence, a humility that refrains from proclaiming our spiritual insights, allowing God's transformative work within us to unfold in His perfect timing.



As we journey through Lent, let the Transfiguration inspire us to ascend our own spiritual mountains. Seek moments of encounter with the divine, but do not linger there. Listen to the voice of Jesus in the ordinary and maintain a humble silence, allowing God's transformative grace to shape our hearts. Just as the disciples followed Jesus down the mountain, may our Lenten reflections propel us toward a deeper, obedient discipleship, rooted in the mystery of the Transfiguration.
