




## HOLY, HOLY, HOLY

One of my assignments in the Theological Foundations course at St. Norbert College for the students is to complete three or four connection experiences which can be short background papers on subjects they find interesting in class. One class I brought in my favorite hymn, Holy, Holy Holy and sang it while studying the Blessed Trinity. The following information about the song was submitted by Addison Baeseman, one of my students, from whom I got permission to share her fascinating report.



'Holy, Holy, Holy' is a popular hymn written by Reginald Heber in 1826. It was published the same year by his wife. Heber was an Anglican bishop and deemed a Christian hero to some. He passed the same year this was written, which is why it was pushed to be published by his wife. The intention of this hymn was to be sung on Trinity Sunday, between the sermon and the creed.

The song is deemed to be intriguing because the goal was not to praise, but rather encourage the singer with a possibly endless song. The melody from this song comes from John Bacchus Dykes to give the song a unique rhythm and elegance. There are many unique aspects to this hymn, as very few rhyme throughout the hymn in the same way Holy, Holy, Holy does, rhyming the end of each line with holy. There is also much symbolism within the number three in the hymn, to represent the Holy Trinity. This is shown in the shift in the third stanza along with the melodic shift to the rising third within the musical background.

Heber started his interest in poetry, but later shifted to hymns, and earned himself the Newdigate prize. However, the majority of his hymns, Holy, Holy, Holy being a prime example, were not published until 1826, the year of his death. He passed away in 1826 after suffering a stroke.
