






CEMETERY PRICES

- \$750 for parish members
- \$1500 for non-members

LUMEN CHRISTI FARM ADVENT COLLECTION

Lumen Christi Farm is a Catholic retreat center that is run and operated by our parishioners, Mathew and Rachel Langer and Family. The retreat center reflects the light of Christ by following the example of St. Isidore the Farmer and his wife Blessed Maria. This non-profit farming operation has sheep, goats, chickens, kittens, donkeys and more. Not only is faith cultivated at the farm, but food is grown to nourish people in need by donating meat, eggs and produce harvested for distribution to local food pantries.
