

CATHOLIC TITLES

Reverend

This title refers to an ordained minister of the Catholic Church. A deacon is formally addressed as Reverend Mr. Dan Gray. A priest addressed as Reverend Fr. Ron Colombo, and a bishop or archbishop as Most Reverend David L. Ricken.

Very Reverend

This is an honorary title given to priests who hold special administrative or judicial functions in the diocese. It may be given to vicars of the bishop, (those who act in the name of the bishop) seminary rectors, and other officials who exercise various positions of authority in a diocese.

Right Reverend

This title is given to abbots, who hold authority over religious orders. Abbots are not bishops but resemble them in many ways within their religious communities. They have the faculties to confirm within parishes entrusted to their care and to wear a miter and crozier during liturgical celebrations, as do bishops.

Monsignor

Monsignor, addressed as Reverend Msgr. Jim Dillenburg, which in Italian means "My Lord" is an honorary title bestowed

by the Holy Father onto priests in special recognition for service to the Church or who hold special offices in the Church. A monsignor has the privilege of wearing a black cassock with red trim and a purple sash for liturgical ceremonies. 'My Lord' is also a formal address for a bishop. In some countries bishops are addressed as Monsignor.

Vicar

The diocesan bishop appoints priests to represent him in various aspects of diocesan governance. A vicar must always act in accordance with the bishop's intentions as he is an official representative of the Bishop over the matters to which he is assigned. A vicar general represents the Bishop in all matters and is the highest-ranking cleric in authority under the bishop himself. An episcopal vicar represents the bishop in specific areas or activities. An example of an episcopal vicar is a vicar for clergy or vicar for ministers. A judicial vicar represents the Bishop in judicial matters and is the chief judge in a diocesan tribunal. A vicar forane, also referred to as a 'dean' or simply 'vicar' is a priest appointed to exercise limited oversight within a vicariate and to encourage collaboration amongst the parishes within a vicariate.

Diocesan Bishop

The chief shepherd and pastor of the diocese in whose ministry the priests and deacons share in. He is responsible for all pastoral care of governance in a diocese. A diocesan bishop's authority rests only within his territory, and he is accountable directly to Pope Leo XIV and the Holy See. In an archdiocese, the diocesan bishop is an archbishop. In some archdioceses, the diocesan bishop is a cardinal. In still other places, the diocesan bishop is a patriarch.

Auxiliary Bishop

An auxiliary bishop is an ordained bishop who is assigned to assist a diocesan bishop in a diocese. He is usually dependent upon the diocesan bishop for his ministry and function in the diocese, just as is any other diocesan cleric. As a bishop, he has the faculty to confirm and, in some cases, can be granted the faculty to ordain priests. Auxiliary bishops sometimes serve as vicars general, episcopal vicars, or even pastors of parishes.


