Pledge cards were mailed out to over 950 parishioners to invite everyone to consider a weekly increase of their current offering. As of this writing **over 160 parishioners** have graciously returned the Yellow Pledge Cards. THANK YOU! A secondary mailing has been sent out to those who have not returned their commitment card as a gentle reminder.


Our current parish deficit is about one month worth of weekly collections. Some parishes it is suggested that a possible Christmas Gift to the church would mirror that deficit. That means if you give \$100 per month perhaps you would consider donating an additional \$100 at Christmas Time? May God bless each of you as we journey toward the Birth of our Savior.

Bible Good Deeds

We are about a third of the way towards providing a Bible for every child in the parish formation program. These Bibles cost about \$20 per student. We plan to purchase age appropriate Bibles for each child. For instance, *The Bible for Little Ones* (ages 4 to 7), The *St Mary's Press Children's Bible* (ages 8 to 11) and the *Fireside Catholic Youth Bible* for teens. With just 20 sponsors at \$40 each we would reach our goal. You can donate online, through the mail or in the weekly collection and mark your donation as Bibles for Kids.
