

LENT 2023 This Lenten Season we have bountiful resources to support your Lenten Journey of the next 40 days. Please avail yourself of these age appropriate resources.

PLAN FOR SUCCESS Now is the time to plan. As the saying goes:

"If you fail to plan, you plan to fail." Let's take the initiative and make this the best Lent ever by spending time with our Lord Daily. Let's chart our course to the Cross and Beyond! Plan to complete Lent and be able to say to yourself: "This was the best LENT Ever!" Plan, Pray, Give, Fast and Repeat! That is what our Lord asks of us!

LENTEN REGULATIONS: The season of Lent begins on *Ash Wednesday, February 22*. Lent is the principal penitential season in the church year. All the Christian faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of **Self-Denial**, **Serious Prayer**, and the performing of **Deeds of Charity/Almsgiving** in addition to the Lenten regulations which follow.

- Abstinence Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Fast Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two meals should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

 To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


