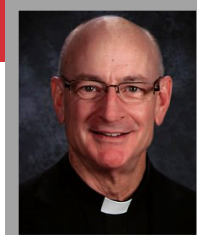

**LENTEN REGULATIONS:** The season of Lent begins on **Ash Wednesday, February 22**. Lent is the principal penitential season in the church year. All the Christian faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of **Self-Denial**, **Serious Prayer**, and the performing of **Deeds of Charity/Almsgiving** in addition to the Lenten regulations which follow.

- **Abstinence** - Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- **Fast** - Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two meals should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

We look forward to the liturgical celebrations of Holy Week, through which the Lord draws us more fully into the mystery of His death and resurrection.

I am writing to ask your financial support for two collections to be taken in all our parishes during these coming days - the Holy Land Collection and the Seminarian Collection, to be taken up correspondingly during the Good Friday service, and then the Easter Vigil Liturgy and Easter Sunday Masses.

Each year, the Holy Father asks each Catholic parish around the world to take up a Good Friday Collection. The purpose of the collection is to keep a Christian presence in the Holy Land. We now have 16 seminarians. You can take a personal role in their formation with a generous gift in the special Easter collection.

## Palm Sunday

Follow the instructions below to create your own palm cross!



Holding a palm strip with the curled edge toward you, fold up the widest end in a loop about 2" long.



Then fold the top piece downward until it covers the top of the previous fold and forms a loop about 2". Place a staple at the intersection.



Bend the thin end of the palm to the right, creasing on a diagonal line.



Fold the palm behind the cross, forming a loop about 1 1/2" on the left. Secure in the center with another staple.



Continue the fold toward the front of the cross forming a loop 1 1/2" on the left. Secure it with another staple.



Wrap the remainder of the palm over the top-right angle of the cross, bringing it straight across the back and over the top-left angle to the front. Cross it diagonally to the bottom-right corner.



Straighten across the back and bring it to the front from the bottom-left corner. Bring it from the bottom-left corner to the top-right corner and to the back again.



Weave the small remaining piece in the back under loops and tie it off. If needed, you can use another staple or a drop of glue.



Add dried flowers or a tiny bow.
