





Question: Is the Capital Campaign Extension over now?



Question: How much do we need to meet this Goal?

The 1-Year Extension Goal Range is \$660,000 to \$1 million. Ideally we need about \$450,000 more than the \$330,000 already pledged.

Question: What do we need this for?

Answer: This 1-Year Extension exists to finance debt incurred during the original Capital Campaign as well as the New Air-conditioning unit for the Church and the Parking Lot upgrades.




