

Health Exam Information



Children entering Preschool, Kindergarten or 6th grade must have a *complete written* Health Exam, with up to date Immunizations, turned in to the school office before the first day of school. Children entering Kindergarten, 2nd or 6th grade, are required to have a **Dental Exam** completed. Entering Kindergarteners

must also have an **Eye Exam** by an Optometrist. Please note, **new students transferring** to Illinois from another State or from outside the U.S. must have complete Health, Dental & Eye Exams and up to date Immunizations, regardless of entering grade. <u>All forms should be turned in to the school office on Fee Day.</u>

Sports Physicals

Incoming 5th - 8th graders, participating in the St. Agnes Sports program, are required to have a physical in order to participate. Physicals for all incoming 6th graders are required by the school, however these school physical forms do not cover sports. The *IESA Physical Form* must be completed. A copy of the physical should be dated for the 2023-2024 school year and must be <u>submitted before sports practices begin</u>.



Prayer for the Year of Eucharistic Revival


