

Health Exam Information Children entering Preschool, Kindergarten or 6th grade must have a complete written Health Exam,

with up to date Immunizations, turned in to the school office before the first day of school. Children entering Kindergarten, 2nd or 6th grade, are required to have a **Dental Exam** completed. Entering Kindergarteners

must also have an Eye Exam by an Optometrist. Please note, new students transferring to Illinois from another State or from outside the U.S. must have complete Health, Dental & Eye Exams and up to date Immunizations, regardless of entering grade. All forms should be turned in to the school office on Fee Day.

Sports Physicals

Incoming 5th - 8th graders, participating in the St. Agnes Sports program, are required to have a physical in order to participate. Physicals for all incoming 6th graders are required by the school, however these school physical forms do not cover sports. The IESA Physical Form must be completed. A copy of the physical should be dated for the 2023-2024 school year and must be submitted before sports practices begin.






EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS
