If you want to be truly happy, live your life for others!

Welcome to a New Church Year and the First Sunday of Advent! Here is the symbolism of the Advent Wreath. The wreath is circular and has no end or beginning which symbolizes ETERNITY. The wreath has three purple and one rose colored candle. Each week another candle is lit to illustrate the coming Savior, the Light of The WORLD overcoming the darkness of sin and evil. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday called Gaudete Sunday. It means Joy in anticipation of the birth of the Christ. The Evergreen represents that even in the "dead of winter" life still exists and can even flourish. Do you have an Advent wreath in your home? Maybe now is a good time to add this deeply rooted tradition to your home.

PRAYER OF BLESSING OF AN ADVENT WREATH: "Lord God your Church joyfully awaits the coming of its Savior, who enlightens our hearts and dispels the darkness of ignorance and sin. Pour forth your blessings upon us as we light the candles of this wreath; may their light reflect the splendor of Christ, who is Lord, for ever and ever. Amen.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK** This beautiful Sacrament of physical, emotional, relational and Spiritual Healing is available after any parish Mass. Just ask the priest after Mass.

**RECONCILIATION** Prepare the way of the Lord at Christmas by receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession). Saturdays from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Or ask the priest after any Mass.






