Now that we have hope we can begin to experience peace. Peace comes in many differing forms. A good nights sleep, a feeling of calmness, mental focus, and an absence of malice or grumpiness are all signs that we are heading in the correct direction. Peace is a byproduct of focused hope. That means as we begin to more closely live and relate in a manner that mirrors that of Jesus Christ, we too become more at peace with ourselves and others. Peace does not mean perfection though. It means right relationship with God and others. Though broken, we are focused on the goal of meeting our God by living that in the present moment. Let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me!

And the great news is we already have \$152,000 pledged to this final phase of our capital campaign extension which will formally end on March 30, 2024. That day just happens to be the Easter Vigil! What a perfect day to mark this milestone and perhaps have a parish event sometime soon after that!
