



A message from Fr. Dan

Starting around Thanksgiving 2023 there has been an increase in Covid-19, RSV and a variety of other cold and flu symptoms impacting many of us. Most of these illnesses had the same symptoms, yet differing levels of severity which affected a variety of age groups. The persistent and unforgiving symptoms have plagued many of us for weeks and even months now.

The Sacred Scriptures this Sunday all speak about healing. This is good news. Another timely event is the St. Blaise blessing of the throats which is celebrated on Saturday, February 3, 2024. Due to its proximity to the weekend we are happy to offer the Blessing of St. Blaise at the end of each Mass this weekend.

St. Blaise was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century and was martyred. This is all we know for sure. The legend of St. Blaise maintains that when St. Blaise was in prison, awaiting execution, a young boy was brought to him with a chicken or fish bone lodged in his throat. St. Blaise was known for his power to heal and he healed the boy through prayer, dislodging the bone. After that, St. Blaise was awarded the crown of martyrdom during a time of great persecution.

The formula for the blessing of St. Blaise is:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness: in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

It may be given by a deacon or priest who also makes the sign of the cross. A designated lay person may also administer the blessing but does not make the sign of the cross. The fullness of the blessing resides in both instances.




World Marriage Day **Celebration Mass**
