Student Council Elections

Student Council Elections will take place Friday, October 6. Those running for offices or commissions will be giving their election speeches in the Gym with grades 5, 6, 7 & 8 present. Following the speeches, students in grades 5, 6, 7 and 8 will cast their votes for the following: President (1), Vice-President (1), Secretary (1), Treasurer (1), Christian Action Commissioners/Peace Builder Commissioners (2), Service Commissioners (2) and Spirit Commissioners (2). Those elected to offices and commissions will also serve as

representatives for each grade. Meetings will take place on the third Monday of each month at 12:00 p.m. until 12:45 p.m. - this is the Jr. High lunch & recess time.

Vision and Hearing Screening

Vision and Hearing screenings will be done, as mandated, on **Tuesday, October 10, 2023** for St. Agnes students. Vision Screening is required for preschool, kindergarten, second and eighth graders and for all students who are new to the school. Hearing Screening is for preschool, kindergarten, first, second and third graders and for all students who are new to the school. The testing is conducted by qualified staff. Vision screening is not a substitute for a complete eye and vision evaluation by an eye doctor. Your child is not required to undergo this vision screening **if** an optometrist or ophthalmologist has completed and signed a report form indicating that an examination has been administered within the previous 12 months and that evaluation is on file at the school. If a vision examination report **is not** on file at the school for your child, your child (preschool, kindergarten, second, eighth and any new student to the school) will be screened. Parents from other grades who have a concern about vision and/or hearing for your child should contact the school office so that he/she may be included in the screening.

Continue to enjoy the lovely fall weather. It's supposed to be a bit cooler over the next few days but the sun will be shining. It might be the perfect time to visit a pumpkin patch :). Have a wonderful three-day weekend!!!

ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Pam Kink, School Secretary (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org). **A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days.** If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A written note in advance of the appointment is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Pam Kink (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org) as well. **If your child will be arriving late please indicate if he/she is a hot or cold lunch when contacting the school. A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.**

KINDERGARTEN NEWS – Mrs. Steinkruger

The food drive is well underway! Please consider donating to try to help us "six-peat" a victory! We are collecting food through Tuesday, October 31st! Also, make sure to turn in your field trip permission slip forms and money (\$8 per person)! These forms and money are due on Friday, October 13th! We also received an update on our cow Leah. Leah is now two months old and weighs 150 pounds! She no longer drinks out of a bottle and eats a mix of hay and silage. Adult cows drink about 30-50 gallons of water a day (about a bathtub full) and eat around 100 pounds of food (that's like 300 peanut and butter sandwiches) a day! To eat that much, cows spend about 8 hours a day eating.

In ABC Bootcamp this week we are focusing on letters Ww, Xx, Yy, and Zz. In religion, we are learning that God's love makes us special and how God has given us all special talents. Your child needs to be able to make the sign of the cross (in the correct order and with the correct hand) and recite the Grace Before Meals prayer by Friday, October 20th (end of quarter 1). We have been practicing both of these things multiple times a day in our classroom. Our sight words are purple, you, and do. These are our last red sight words. At this point, your child should know all of the red words. He/she will need to be able to read all of them by Friday, October 20th (end of Quarter 1). We will be starting our orange words next week. In science we are talking all about our five senses. In math we are reviewing lessons, identifying numbers 1-5, and drawing diagrams to solve problems. Our theme in reading is the three little pigs. We read "The Three Little Pigs" by Paul Galdone. We talked about key details, characters, and how to retell the story. We also learned all about our start student this week, Colin Barber!

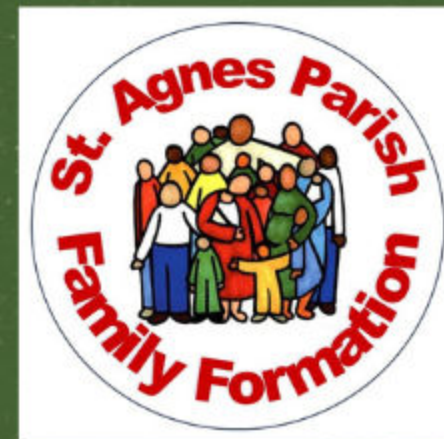
