Dear St. Agnes School Parents,

Next Monday, November 20 and Tuesday, November 21, the St. Agnes School faculty looks forward to welcoming you to Parent/Teacher Conferences. These scheduled appointments give teachers the opportunity to provide more detailed information about the progress and growth of your child(ren). **Students in grades 4 - 8 are required to be present with their parents so that they may be a part of the conversation.** If you still have not scheduled a conference time, please do so immediately. Scrip Requirement/Availability

Scrip cards make great Christmas gifts and they are available each day in the Parish office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., or you may choose to submit an order to the office or order online at any time. Remember, for those of you who opted to purchase Scrip, we ask that you purchase \$2,000.00 in Scrip cards throughout the school year. Christmas gift buying is a wonderful way to achieve this goal!

Recess

Daily recess will take place outside as much as possible and weather permitting. With the weather becoming much colder we would like everyone to be covered and warm while they are outside. Girls that wear uniform skirts to school may wear a pair of pants underneath their skirts to protect their legs while outside. When inside pants may be kept in the student's

bookbag. All students should come to school with a warm coat, hat and gloves during this time of year.

ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Pam Kink, School Secretary (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org). **A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days.** If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A written note in advance of the appointment is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Pam Kink (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org) as well. **If your child will be arriving late please indicate if he/she is a hot or cold lunch when contacting the school. A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.**

KINDERGARTEN NEWS – Mrs. Steinkruger

This week in phonics we focused on the letter u word families (-ub, -ut, -un, and -ug). In religion we are learning to appreciate the signs of God's love and that Jesus is the greatest sign of God's love. Our sight words are they, said, and want. We have officially finished our Orange Rainbow Sight Words! We will be moving onto our yellow sight words. If your child is still working on his/her orange words, please continue to practice with them at home as we will be moving on in class! 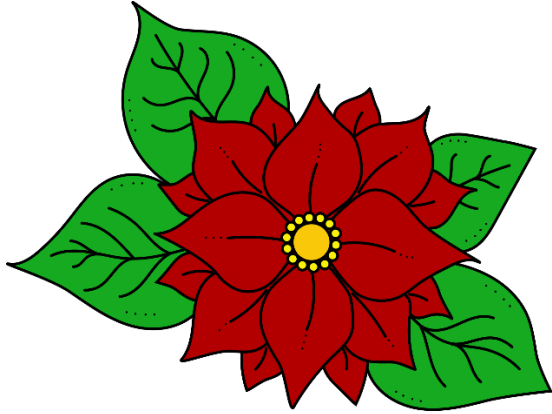

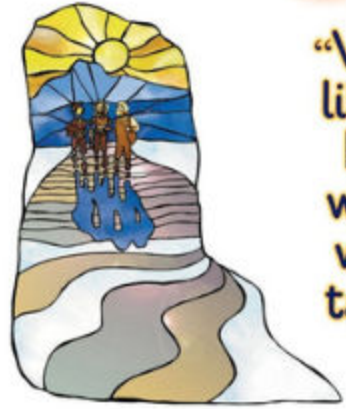
