Dear St. Agnes School Parents,

And so the season of Advent is about to begin. When you attend Mass this weekend you will witness the lighting of the first Advent candle. We continue to await the birth of Jesus over the next three weeks. This is a very exciting time of year filled with much anticipation. We will have our own Advent prayer services over the next three Mondays and an Epiphany prayer service the Monday we return from our Christmas break. You may have your own family tradition such as opening windows on an Advent calendar, adding pieces to a Nativity set during each day of Advent, or counting down the days until Christmas on an Advent chain. Whatever your tradition is, remember that this helps prepare our hearts for Christ's birth.

### **Scrip Requirement/Availability**

Scrip cards make great Christmas gifts and they are available each day in the Parish office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., or you may choose to submit an order to the office or order online at any time. Remember, for those of you who opted to purchase Scrip, we ask that you purchase \$2,000.00 in Scrip cards throughout the school year. Christmas gift buying is a wonderful way to achieve this goal!

### **Recess**

Daily recess will take place outside as much as possible and weather permitting. With the weather becoming much colder we would like everyone to be covered and warm while they are outside. Girls that wear uniform skirts to school may wear a pair of pants underneath their skirts to protect their legs while outside. When inside pants may be kept in the student's bookbag. All students should come to school with a warm coat, hat and gloves during this time of year.

### **Christmas Program**

Our annual Christmas program will take place on Thursday, December 14 at 7:00 p.m. in the school gym. Ms. Cicely McCain and Ms. Jessica Smith, our music instructors, have been busy preparing our K - 4 students and the Singing Aces Choir for this evening of Christmas music. We hope to see you there!!

### **ABSENTEES**

**Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day.** Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Pam Kink, School Secretary ([pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org](mailto:pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org)). **A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days.** If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

### **LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS**

**Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A written note in advance of the appointment** is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.**

## **KINDERGARTEN NEWS – Mrs. Steinkruger**

We are getting ready to start the season of Advent this Sunday. We have been talking about preparing for the coming of Jesus and things that we can do during the Advent season. We will be doing some Advent calendars in class and creating an Advent book which helps us realize the reason for the season.

This week in ABC Bootcamp we are learning about the digraph SH. We learned that SH can come at the beginning of a word or at the end of a word. The students have also been working on forming his/her letters correctly. Starting at the top and going all the way to the bottom is the correct formation. We've learned that some letters get to "hang" below the line. Please make sure to reinforce this concept when working with your child on his/her homework. In religion we have been talking all about Advent. We learned the first candle is the purple hope candle. Our sight words are here, me, and this. We have started the yellow words and officially finished the orange words. Friendly reminder, that your child needs to know his/her orange sight words by Friday, January 12th (end of quarter 2). In science we are focusing on animals in the winter. Our theme in reading this week is polar bears. We read "Ice Bear" by Nicola Davies. We practiced making connections and questioning. In math we are counting and recognizing numerals to 50. We are counting to 100 by ones and tens. We also celebrated the 70th day of school with an activity from Zero the Hero! This week we had an awesome time learning all about our star student, Ella Parks.
