Message from the Principal

Dear St. Agnes School Parents,

The month of February is scurrying along quite quickly. Next week you will receive reregistration forms for the 2023-2024 school year. The youngest/only child will be bringing home an envelope on Monday that will contain: 1. Tuition & Fees sheet; 2. Re-registration form; 3. Tuition payment preference form; 4. Family School Agreement form; and, 5. A letter explaining the Family School Agreement form. You are asked to have forms 2, 3, & 4 completed and submitted to the school office, along with a \$150.00 registration fee per family, by Tuesday, February 28. If your child(ren) will not be returning to school next school year, please indicate that on form 2 and turn it into the office. We look forward to partnering with you, once again, in the faith formation and education of your child(ren).

<u>Letter Explaining New Family School Agreement</u>

Attached to this newsletter is a copy of the letter explaining the new Family School Agreement that was mentioned above. This letter provides information regarding the expectations for our school families, Sunday Mass attendance for our Catholic families, and contribution envelopes. Please read this letter very carefully as it gives a good overview of the Family School Agreement that you will be receiving in your re-registration packets.

Tuition/Fees 2023-2024

You will be receiving a Tuition & Fees schedule in your re-registration packets on Monday. You will see that there will now only be a registration fee of \$150 per family and an 8th grade Graduation fee of \$50.00. All other fees have been eliminated. You'll also notice a reduction in tuition price for our non-Catholic families who have more than one child.

We welcome back to St. Agnes School Mrs. Beth LaFata, who will serve as our school counselor. Mrs. LaFata served in this role previously and is very happy to be back among the students and staff. She will be at school each Tuesday (all day) and Thursday morning to work with individual students and small groups. We are thrilled to have her back at St. Agnes!!

ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Mrs. Katie Harris, School Secretary (kharris@stagnescatholicschool.org). A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days. If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A <u>written note in advance of the appointment</u> is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Katie Harris (kharris@stagnescatholicschool.org) as well. A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.

KINDERGARTEN – Mrs. Steinkruger

We received an update on our cow Lollipop! She is now 6 months old and weighs around 375 pounds! When she's grown she'll produce milk that can be used to make cheese. Farmer Meng also informed us that February is children's dental health month. We learned that cheese is one of the healthiest snacks for our teeth. It fights cavities and protects our teeth from the acid that weakens them. We also learned that chocolate milk is just as good as white milk! This shocked many kids in the class!

In phonics this week we are learning our (R blends) br-, cr-, dr-, fr-, and gr-. In religion we are learning that when we help and care, we live God's love. We are also learning that Mass helps us celebrate God's love as Jesus did. Our sight words are make, run, and jump. In math we are learning to model subtraction, solve subtraction problems and learning the symbols (-) minus sign and the (=) equals sign. In reading, our theme this week is winter. We read "The Mitten" by Jan Brett. We talked about key details, cause and effect, visualizing, and problem/solution.

Continue to practice your Rainbow sight words!!! Friendly reminder that students must know their yellow and green words by Friday, March 17th! Continue to practice the Hail Mary prayer as well! Students must be able to recite this by the end of the quarter (Friday, March 17th) as well!



Dear Parents,

Thank you for choosing a Catholic education for the spiritual and academic development of your child(ren). A year ago, we, the undersigned pastors of Catholic schools in the city of Springfield, envisioned the transformative effect of a thoughtful plan for discipleship and stewardship.

According to research, Mass-attending families are happier, have stronger marriages, raise more service-oriented children, and have fewer mental health issues. Simply put, families that actively participate in the Mass are holy, healthy, and happy. As Catholics, we attribute these blessings to the power of the true presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, and we want all families to experience these blessings.

To that end, and in support of the Diocesan Year of the Eucharist, we are launching an initiative to encourage regular Sunday Mass attendance among our registered parishioners. As the primary ministry of the parish, schools are a vibrant center of catechesis, faith formation, discipleship, and stewardship. It is our hope that Catholic school families will lead this initiative.

For the 2023-2024 school year, our parish schools in Springfield will introduce a new Family School Agreement that outlines the role and expectations of school families. All families are expected to fulfill the obligations of the Family School Agreement. Catholic families have a further expectation of weekly Mass participation. We recognize instances of travel, sickness, and the scheduling challenges of modern life may lead your family to attend Mass at various parishes, a benefit afforded to us as the Universal Church. However, the parish family is an extension of your domestic family, and just like any family, we miss each other when we are apart. Your family's Mass attendance at your registered parish is expected at least 51% of the time.

Registered parishioners in the Springfield area will receive updated Sunday stewardship envelopes beginning in the summer of 2023. These envelopes are an invitation to consider how to pray, serve, and give as a family each week. All Catholic school families should place their envelope in the collection basket during Sunday Mass, whether or not a financial contribution is made. Envelopes will be used to measure parishioner participation in order to help identify opportunities for engagement, allocation of resources, and to address faith needs across our Catholic community in the Springfield area.

We are excited to launch this initiative, knowing that their participation in Mass and the Eucharist will transform the lives of our parishioners through the graces of the Holy Spirit. More information will be provided in the school's registration packet.

May God continue to bless you and our parish families in the year ahead,




