Message from the Principal

Dear St. Agnes School Parents,

Welcome back!! The 2023-2024 school year has begun and we're off to a roaring start! All students are settling into their classrooms and are learning the routine of the school day. While visiting all of the classrooms and students yesterday and this morning, most have said that they are glad to be back at school and with their friends. This certainly seems to be the case as there are many smiles upon faces and lively conversations taking place - especially during lunch time:). The school building has come back to life and this is such a pleasure to witness.

Back-to-School Night

Our St. Agnes School "Back-to-School" Night will be held on Wednesday, August 30 beginning at 6:00 p.m. This event is for parents only so we ask that one parent from each family attend. This evening gives us an opportunity to present to you our goals and activities for the school year and allows teachers to share with parent's information about curriculum, learning standards, class schedules, and expectations. The evening will begin in the gym with general comments and introductions of staff. Following there will be three 20-minute classroom sessions that teachers will conduct. Please attend your child(ren's) classroom teacher session. Mrs. Karen White and Mrs. Cathy Becker will be presenting, during the second and third sessions, information regarding our Rediker system, and the Safe Environment and Family Service Hour program. Scrip will also be available for purchase that evening.

M.A.G.I.C. Match Program

We have in place at St. Agnes School, a M.A.G.I.C Match program where you, the business you work for, or just individual businesses can be a classroom sponsor for one or more of our classes. This program provides \$50.00 a month for ten months, or \$500.00 a year, that is given to classes to be used for learning materials or educational experiences that do not come out of the regular budget. Morning Arrival/Afternoon Dismissal

Please review the diagram that is located on our school website www.stagnescatholicparish.org regarding arrival and dismissal of students. The link to this is located under school, current families, arrival and dismissal procedures. The link to this is located on the front page. All students should be let out on the north side of the school beginning at 7:35 a.m. where there are teachers and patrols on duty. Please do not drop off children at the church or south side of the school where we do not have adults or patrols on duty. Preschool families utilize the Gym parking area at dismissal time as preschoolers will be walked out to parents through the gym doors at 3:05 p.m. When pulling into the parking areas, preschool families are asked to enter the parking areas on the north side and pull all the way up to the parking places facing south so that when you leave you can turn right and drive around the back of the school and exit the drive near the PeaceBuilder playground. Please do not go against the traffic. At dismissal time our K - 8 families without preschoolers should park in the area near the field, on the east side of the tennis courts or the church parking lot. Only preschool families use the parking areas nearest the school except the families that purchased the special parking spots at the St. Agnes

Auction event. Do not park across the street on Amos and expect children to walk across to you, at the back end of the school without permission for special circumstances, or in Fr. Dan & Fr. Christopher's driveway. Please watch your speed once driving onto the parish and school grounds and watch for moving children. For everyone's safety, please adhere to these policies.

And so tomorrow ends our first three days of the new school year. Next week will be a full week with 3:10 p.m. dismissals, and our preschoolers will also be joining us:). There are many fun days ahead!! We are all very fortunate to be part of this wonderful family that we call St. Agnes School and Church.

ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Pam Kink, School Secretary (pkink@stagnescatholicschool.org). A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days. If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A <u>written note in advance of the appointment</u> is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Pam Kink (pkink@stagnescatholicschool.org) as well. A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.
