This is a day of attendance for students and they should be dropped off at the normal drop-off time. Dismissal is at 11:30 a.m. for those students not leaving with grandparents. There is no Late Day on Grandparents' Day.

M.A.G.I.C. Match Sponsorship

Parents' Club Black Friday Raffle

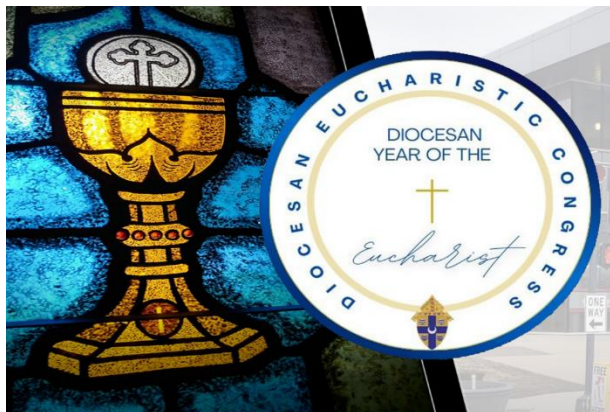

Arrival and Dismissal

The first bell of the day rings at 7:45 a.m. for children to have time to get themselves settled for the day. The tardy bell rings at 8:00 a.m. Please have your children here for school **on time!** When children come in every day tardy, it does not allow them time to prepare for their classes and it causes teachers to repeat directions, making other children wait. Our school day begins at 8:00 a.m. Please help us keep to this schedule. At dismissal time, parking along the north side of the tennis courts is not permitted unless you are a parent picking up a preschooler. Cars parking on the east side of the tennis courts are the cars that will be dismissed first in the line-up of cars for dismissal. Those cars should be turning left to go north out of the drive near the PeaceBuilders' Playground or going straight across the street. **The parking area near Fr. Dan and Fr. Christopher's garage is not for school families at any time of the day.** Our parents who are supervising at lunch time, in the cafeteria, on the playground or in the library are asked to park in the back of the school or along the drive near the PeaceBuilder playground. Also, remember to drive **SLOWLY** through the parking lot at all times. Please help us keep your children and all children safe!

ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Pam Kink, School Secretary (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org). **A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days.** If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A written note in advance of the appointment is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Pam Kink (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org) as well. **If your child will be arriving late please indicate if he/she is a hot or cold lunch when contacting the school.** A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. **A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.**

KINDERGARTEN NEWS – Mrs. Steinkruger

We are officially on day 17 of school! The kindergartners have learned how to transition for centers and what we do at each center. They loved exploring the science center and writing center which are new this year!

We also adopted a cow in partnership with the St. Louis Dairy Council program. Our class will receive monthly updates from our farmer, Farmer Graves in Dundas, Illinois. We took a class vote on her name and the winner was Leah! Leah is 2 weeks old and weighs 80 pounds. She drinks special milk out of a bottle and lives in a hutch which is a special type of house for the baby calves.

In phonics this week we are learning about letters Ff, Gg and Hh in ABC Bootcamp. In religion, we are finishing our creation books and learning about the gifts of God's love. Our sight words this week are orange, the, and we. In science we are continuing our study of being a scientist. In math, we are practicing writing numbers 6, 7, and 8. 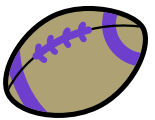

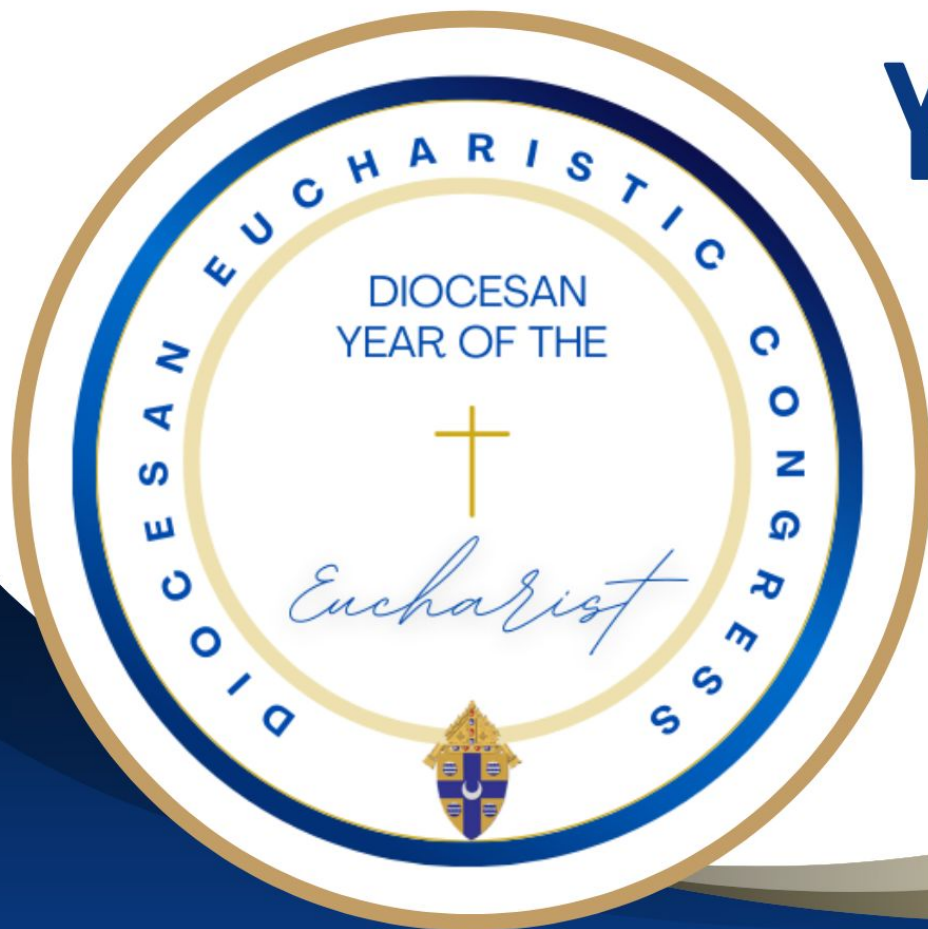
