Tardiness of Students

We have several families whose children are tardy quite often. Please follow the school's arrival policies and be sure children are here on time each day. When a child is late, s(he) is at a disadvantage as time is needed to organize oneself at the beginning of the day. It also requires the teacher to back track and lose time with instruction. Late students also get embarrassed at walking into class each day while the class waits for them to get settled. Please help us start on time each day by leaving home a little earlier.

Water Bottles

All students have been asked to bring to school a water bottle that is no larger than 24 ounces to utilize throughout the day. Many students are forgetting these at home. Please check in the morning before leaving home that your student(s) has a water bottle with them.

ABSENTEES




