Second Grade First Reconciliation Preparation

Our second graders will soon be receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Wednesday, February 28. In order to prepare for this a Family Orientation Meeting will take place on Sunday, January 14 at 10:00 a.m. (after 9:00 a.m. Mass and before 11:00 a.m. Mass). You

will receive your child's preparation packet, renew your own understanding of Confession, and get a sneak peek into Confirmation and First Communion in the Restored Order. Please mark this date and time on your calendar.

Tardiness of Students

We have several families whose children are tardy quite often. **Please follow the school's arrival policies and be sure children are here on time each day.** When a child is late, s(he) is at a disadvantage as time is needed to organize oneself at the beginning of the day. It also requires the teacher to back track and lose time with instruction. Late students also get embarrassed at walking into class each day while the class waits for them to get settled. **Please help us start on time each day by leaving home a little earlier.**

Chromebook Cases/Sleeves

This is a reminder that all students who transport their school-issued chromebook from home to school must store their device in a protective case/sleeve. Those students without one will need to acquire one on their own or purchase one from the school office. We have several sleeves for sale for \$15.00. Please make the office aware if your child wishes to purchase one.

Tuition Payment

ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. and may leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Pam Kink, School Secretary (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org). **A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days.** If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A **written note in advance of the appointment** is to be sent to the school office through the teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Pam Kink (pkink@stagnescatholicsschool.org) as well. **If your child will be arriving late please indicate if he/she is a hot or cold lunch when contacting the school.** **A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office.** **A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.**

Social Media

As the second semester begins at St. Agnes I will be visiting classrooms to discuss Social Media and particularly how to be safe while using it. We will explore the etiquette of when to use it as well as the benefits and drawbacks of sharing on various platforms. I hope you find the following article helpful when discussing social media with your children.

Monitoring kids on social media; Experts agree that parental monitoring is crucial when kids are starting to use social media. "Access to social media should come with a talk beforehand of what you as parents feel is acceptable and unacceptable behavior." Parents should have access to their child's platforms to help them understand what is appropriate and inappropriate to post." The most important thing is to pay attention to the amount of time your child spends on social media. There should be a healthy balance of face-to-face friend activity, family time, and social media.
