## MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear St. Agnes School Parents,
The month of February is scurrying along quite quickly. Next week you will receive reregistration forms for the 2024-2025 school year. Family School Agreement form. You are asked to have forms $2,3, \& 4$ completed and submitted to the school office, along with a $\$ 150.00$ registration fee per family, by Thursday, February 29. If your child(ren) will not be returning to school next school year, please indicate that on form 2 and turn it into the office. We look forward to partnering with you, once again, in the faith formation and education of your child(ren).

## ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. ## Program Fee \& Financial Assistance

We believe that building confidence and setting young girls down the path of a healthy lifestyle are priceless! However, there are real costs associated with delivering the Girls on the Run program to over 1,000 girls per year.

The program fee is $\mathbf{\$ 1 5 0}$ per girl. This amount is subsidized by sponsors of Girls on the Run of Central Illinois, meaning the cost of providing programming and operating our nonprofit is greater than the program fee (approximately $\$ 205$ per girl).

## How to Apply for Financial Assistance - NEW PROCESS



We are proud to honor our commitment that no girl is ever turned away for the inability to pay the registration fee; therefore, we offer financial assistance (scholarships) using a sliding scale based on household income.

| Household Income Guidelines | Sliding Scale Fee |
| :---: | :---: |
| Under $\$ 25,000$ | $\$ 25$ |
| $\$ 25,001-\$ 35,000$ | $\$ 35$ |
| $\$ 35,001-\$ 50,000$ | $\$ 50$ |
| $\$ 50,001-\$ 75,000$ | $\$ 75$ |
| $\$ 75,001-\$ 100,000$ | $\$ 100$ |
| Over $\$ 100,000$ (or decline to state) | $\$ 150$ |

The financial assistance process is now included within the online program registration. To use financial assistance, simply answer the questions during registration, and the computer will determine your eligibility based on household income and adjust the fee accordingly. If you need assistance beyond where your family falls in the above chart, please email darian@GOTRcentralillinois.org with information on your specific circumstances and what amount you can afford. Our minimum fee for any participant is $\$ 25$.
