## Homework Requests

Homework requests are accepted when reporting an absence. If requested, homework will be gathered throughout the day. When compiled, it will be sent home with a requested student or placed on the benches outside of the office. If homework is not requested, it will be available for the student to obtain when they return to school.

## Tuition Assistance

Families in need of Tuition Assistance are able to go through FACTS Grant \& Aid and complete the forms for this online at https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. Please take the time to complete this application if your family is in need of tuition assistance for the upcoming school year. If this is the first time that you have utilized this service, you will first need to create an account. After that is completed, you'll then follow the steps to complete the forms. The deadline for submitting applications is May 1, 2024.

## Kindergarten Screenings for 2024-2025

Current Preschool 4 -year-old families enrolling their child in kindergarten will have a kindergarten screening on Friday, March 22. Mrs. Steinkruger, our kindergarten teacher, will be conducting these screenings. Those students in our Preschool 4 -year-old classroom who will be continuing on to kindergarten at St. Agnes School will be escorted by school staff to the kindergarten classroom that day and will be screened. Parents need not be in attendance for this. Children eligible for kindergarten and are new to St. Agnes School will be contacted to set up a screening time.

## Family Service Hours

Remember, each family is required to complete 20 hours of service per school year. You may submit your service hours on the Service Hour Google Form located on our school website. Statements regarding your service hour status were sent home with the youngest/only child recently.

## SCRIP Program

The Parents' Club SCRIP program ends April $30^{m}$ for this school year. On May ${ }^{\text {n }}$, the program begins anew for the following school year. Remember that $40 \%$ of what is earned as profit
goes to you to be applied to school expenses. The other 60\% is used by the Parents' Club for their activities. Parents who have not fulfilled commitments will be asked to pay the buyout of \$125.00 in May.

## Summer Camp Information

We are now opening up the Summer Camp program to current PreK-4, Kindergarten, 1st grade and 2nd grade students. The program will run for two four-week sessions beginning on June 3 thru June 28 and July 8 thru Aug. 2. Time of the program will be 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday.

There will be a $\$ 50$ registration fee per family. Weekly 5 -day rate will be $\$ 175$ per child. If you choose to come less than 5 days a week the rate will be $\$ 40$ per day per child. A registration form is attached to this newsletter. Please return completed registration form with registration fee to the school office by Monday, April 15. More details regarding the daily activities will be forth-coming.

## Inter-State Studio Spring Pictures PREPAY Process:

- Interstate Studio will only be photographing a child whose family has ordered pictures prior to picture day. Please have your order placed by midnight the night before picture day.
- When you pre-order online, a student does not have to turn anything into the photographer. If using a physical order form, please have your child bring his/her order envelope to the photographer on picture day. To help eliminate missing anyone who pre-orders, the school and the photographer will receive an email of the students who ordered online.
- The prints will arrive at the school roughly 2-3 weeks after picture day.

## ABSENTEES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. ## SUMMER HANDWRITING/FINE MOTOR BOOTCAMP - Mrs. Steinkruger

Hello! I am offering a handwriting/fine motor workshop this summer. This workshop is for incoming first graders and second graders (current Kindergarteners and first graders). I will be working with the students for 1 hour once a week. The workshop will start with a ten-minute whole group lesson and then I will divide the students into four groups for small group learning (centers). Two of the centers will focus on fine motor skills (scissor skills, using tweezers, endurance in coloring, etc.) and the other two on handwriting (forming letters correctly, pencil grip, endurance in writing etc.).
