Message from the Principal

Dear St. Agnes School Parents,

This Tuesday our 2nd through 8th grade students had the opportunity to attend our school Reconciliation service. What a nice way to finish out the season of Lent and enter into the Easter season fresh and renewed. We extend our thanks to Fr. Brian Alford, Fr. Joe Malloy, Fr. Tony Philip, Fr. Dan and Fr. Zach for being in attendance and hearing confessions.

8th Grade Scholarship Opportunities

St. Agnes School and Parish offers to 8th graders three scholarship opportunities for students continuing their Catholic education. On Tuesday of last week, 8th grade students and parents were emailed applications for the following: the St. Agnes Parish Scholarship, the Monsignor Patrick J. Wright Memorial Scholarship, and the Edward Goetz Memorial Scholarship. These applications must be completed and turned in to Mrs. Cunningham by Tuesday, April 15.

Family Service Hours

Remember, each family K - 8 family is required to complete 20 hours of service per school year, and each Preschool Only family is required to complete 10 hours of service per year. You may submit your service hours on the Service Hour Google Form located on our school website.

SCRIP Raise Right Program

The Parents' Club SCRIP Raise Right program ends April 30th for this school year. On May 1st, the program begins anew for the following school year. Remember that 40% of what is earned as profit goes to you to be applied to school expenses. The other 60% is used by the Parents' Club for their activities. Parents who have not fulfilled commitments will be asked to pay the buyout at the end of the school year.

Tuition Assistance

Families in need of Tuition Assistance are able to go through FACTS Grant & Aid and complete the forms for this online at <https://online.factsmt.com/aid>. Please take the time to complete this application if your family needs tuition assistance. If this is the first time that you have utilized this service, you will first need to create an account. After that is completed, you'll then follow the steps to complete the forms.

Super Service Saturday

On Saturday, April 12th, we will be hosting a spring clean-up event as an opportunity for service at St. Agnes. The clean-up can be worked by parents and students and will be held from 9:00 a.m. – Noon. All are asked to gather in the school cafeteria where assignments will be given out. This is a wonderful opportunity to attain family service hours. Remember, **K - 8 families** need to accumulate **20 hours of service** and **Preschool only families** need to accumulate **10 hours of service** during the school year. When you have completed a service hour opportunity, don't forget to record it on the online Google service form, which can be found on our school website.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE SCHOOL OFFICE DAILY FOR:

SCHOOL ABSENCES

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be absent that day. Homework requests may be made at this time for absences. Parents should call the school office prior to 8:30a.m. Leave a message on the school answering machine if the secretary cannot be reached. An email may also be sent to Mrs. Pam Kink, School Secretary at (pkink@sasaces.org). **A call or email should be made each day the student is absent, unless it is known that the child will miss several consecutive days.** If such is the case, the school can be informed with the first phone call/email of the consecutive absence and the reason.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Each parent/guardian is required to notify the school office if a child will be arriving late or leaving early for an appointment. A written note in advance of the appointment is to be sent to the school office and to the homeroom teacher for the release of a student from school for doctor, dental or other appointments. Emails may be sent to the teacher and to Mrs. Pam Kink (pkink@sasaces.org). **A parent must personally pick up the child at the school office. A student must check in at the school office upon returning from an appointment to get an admit slip to return to class.**

It has now grown into a community movement that now provides 2,000-4,000 meals every week across many different locations in Springfield. 
