Notice is hereby given pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, that the Board of Directors of Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District No. 2C will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on June 10, 2025, at 5:45 p.m., outside the boundaries of the District, at 21100 Carries Ranch Road, Pflugerville, Texas, for the following purposes:

2. Discuss, consider, and take action to approve minutes of May 13, 2025 regular meeting;
3. Receive public comment (*three (3) minutes per speaker; but any person providing public comment through a translator is limited to six (6) minutes, unless the District uses simultaneous translation equipment in a manner that allows the Board to hear the translated public testimony simultaneously with the speaker*);
4. Receive report from District's Engineer and discuss, consider, and take action regarding the same;
5. Discuss, consider, and take action concerning a street lighting service agreement with ONCOR Electric Delivery Company, including the installation of one streetlight along Speidel Drive adjacent to the tennis courts at the Blackhawk Amenity Center;
6. Discuss, consider, and take action concerning License Agreement for the Carries Ranch Recreation Center Pool Facilities;
7. Receive operations report from Crossroads Utility Services and discuss, consider, and take action regarding the same;
8. Receive recreational facilities report and take action as necessary concerning the same, including, but not limited to, maintenance and/or improvements to existing recreational facilities;
9. Discuss, consider, and take action on payment of invoices and bookkeeper's report;
10. Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary concerning Utility Services Agreement between Lakeside WCID No. 2C and Trails at Blackhawk Condominium Community, Inc.;
11. The Board will meet in executive session to receive advice from its attorney regarding Utility Services Agreement between Lakeside WCID No. 2C and Trails at Blackhawk Condominium Community, Inc., in accordance with Texas Government Code § 551.071;
12. Receive update on 2025 Legislative Session;
13. Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary regarding Manville Water Supply Corporation water infrastructure issues;
