From the Desk of Fr. Andrew

February 17, 2019

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time



I hope you had a great week.

As we listen to some of The Beatitudes this week (only four instead of eight in other Gospel accounts) and journey through the month of February (only two Sundays before Ash Wednesday) I thought it will be good to remind

ourselves of the **call to be intentional about getting holy**. Be Holy, is also the theme we are focusing on this year in our Pastoral Plan which follows Archbishop Vigneron's letter, *Unleash the Gospel*, calling us to holiness. We look inward to find where we can see it at work in practical ways in ourselves, our families and our parishes. Here are examples where we see Being Holy in our parish:

First, we must recognize we all are called to holiness because God calls us to be faithful and joyful followers of Jesus Christ, therefore:

- We strive to live out our Baptismal call individually and collectively — dying to the “old” (sin) and rising to the “new” (grace) as embodied in the paschal mystery, leaving behind the “old” habits and embracing “good habits” to see the changes in our communities.

Second, our central task is to make God present in the world and to allow our lives to be challenged and transformed by holiness, therefore:

- We commit ourselves with our eyes focused on Jesus to grow in holiness through prayer, study, and proclamation of the Gospel and celebration of the Eucharist as to become the “face of Christ” to each other, the “living tabernacle” through which Christ is made present to others.

You may be thinking, what does this mean for me? On page 54 in *Unleash the Gospel* there are action steps we are being asked to live by to help us in Being Bold, Holy, and Catholic: personal and communal prayer leading to encounter Jesus anew through Eucharist, Devotions, and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. My question to you is: **are we, have we started to build the culture within our parish to accomplish and support this movement towards our holiness?** Do you see a gap in providing these opportunities? Is there something you believe would enhance and strengthen your faith that we could implement here at St. Clare? Your thoughts and ideas are an important component in strengthening our faith and growing as disciples.

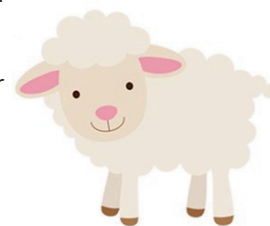



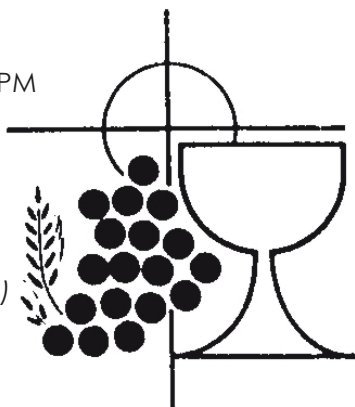
