and me. We are children of God and that calls for involvement, celebration, and participation. Be Bold. Be Holy. Be Catholic


#### **SAINTS OF THE WEEK**

- Tuesday St. Josephine Bakhita (1869-1947) She was a Sudanese-Italian religious sister who lived in Italy for 45 years, after having been a slave in Sudan. In 2000, she was declared a saint
- Wednesday St. Scholastica (480 543) She was born in Italy. According to a ninth centu-

ry tradition, she was the twin sister of Benedict of Nursia, founder of the Benedictine Order.

Friday – Our Lady of Lourdes – is a title of the Mary, mother of Jesus, venerated in honor of the Marian apparitions that occurred in Lourdes, France. The Basilica was built on the place of the apparitions and the sanctuary is visited by millions each year, and Lourdes has become one of the prominent pilgrimage sites of the world.





#### HAPPY WINTER FROM THE 1<sup>ST</sup> GRADE!
