- Preschool 3 and Preschool 4 students are required to wear gym uniforms every day.

- Lunch Tickets are sold in packs of ten for \$35. Milk Tickets are in packs of ten for \$7.50 and are available to purchase on Curriculum Day or by sending the lunch envelope to school with your child.
