Morning Drop Off

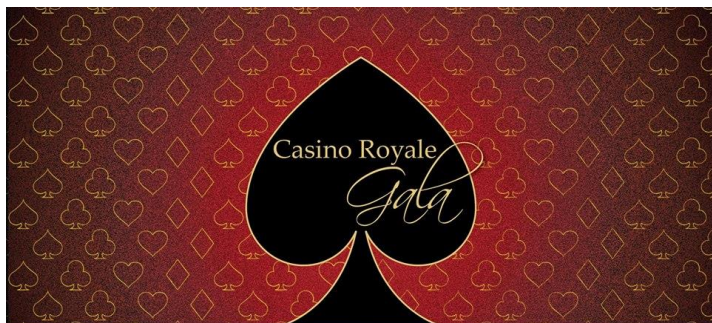
