Between our various programs and age groups, we averaged over 225 of our youth being catechized on any given Sunday! 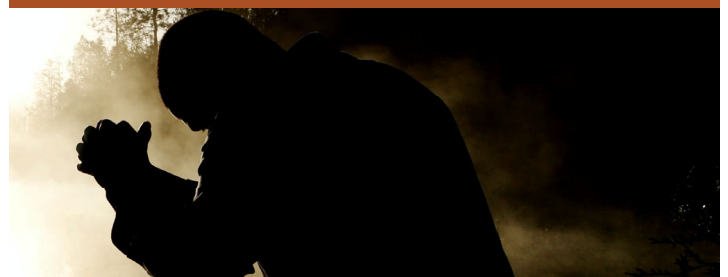

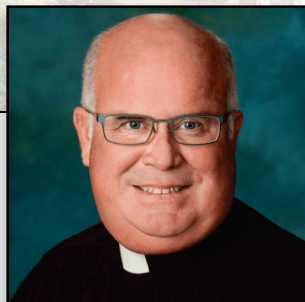
