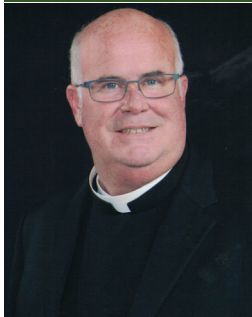

Pastor's Corner



Presentation of the Lord

Next Wednesday, we celebrate the Presentation of our Lord, which is celebrated 40 days after the birth of Jesus. In the Bible, this is

when Jesus was made known to the world and is also called "Candlemas." In Luke's Gospel, Simeon, to whom it was revealed would not die before seeing the Messiah, referred to Jesus, in his prayer after seeing Him, as a "light to reveal God to the nations." The Presentation of the Lord is celebrated with candles signifying the light Christ brings to our life and the grace he bestows on us which frees us from the darkness of sin. For us, this serves as an invitation to be the light of Christ and to allow Him to pour His love into every corner of our lives.

This year, in celebration of Candlemas, we will have a special candle light Mass at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, February 2nd. With the beginning of the New Year, this invitation to be lights of Christ couldn't be more timely. We can use the fresh start of Advent and Christmas to deepen our commitment to growing in relationship with Jesus, receiving Him in the Eucharist and other Sacraments, and thanking Him in prayer.

BSA

In addition, this weekend kicks off the 2022 Bishop's Services Appeal (BSA), which is an annual appeal that helps to support and sustain over 40 programs, ministries and services by the diocese under the direction of our shepherd, Bishop Douglas Deshotel. Many of you became familiar with Bishop Deshotel when he helped out with Sunday Masses here at St. Pius last summer. He has been extremely supportive of individual parishes, and particularly St. Pius X. Bishop Deshotel has a heart of service, commenting when he came to Lafayette that his job was to serve and provide support for his pastors, not vice-versa.

Since 1973, the BSA has been serving others and ministering to those in need. Besides charitable endeavors, the BSA helps to support vocations and services to individual parishes. I encourage all to prayerfully consider giving generously to the BSA this year. As always, thanks so much for your past support, and I hope you are able to continue your generosity in the upcoming year.

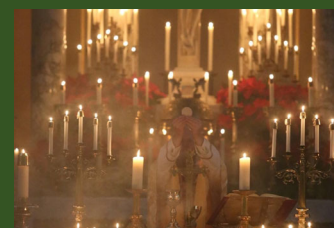

Thank you for your cooperation in helping the parish be good stewards of the resources entrusted to it. We hope sending it via email will allow it to be more accessible to you as well.

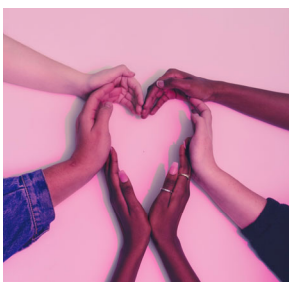

Pray, Serve & Give

TO BE A PROPHET

Today's readings show us what it is like to be a prophet. As Jeremiah recounts his call, God warns him that he will need strength and perseverance to withstand the hostility he will face from "Judah's kings and princes" and "its priests and people" (Jeremiah 1:18b). God also assures him that they "will not prevail over you, for I am with you" (1:19). The psalm reflects both of these struggles as well as deliverance from them ("salvation").

This is exactly what Jesus experiences in today's Gospel. After he claims that his own mission is the same as what Isaiah proclaimed, at first the people marvel at his "gracious words" (Luke 4:22). Soon, however, they become suspicious, skeptical, and hostile, even threatening to kill him. But just as God promised to deliver Jeremiah, so Jesus "passed through the midst of them and went away" (4:30).
