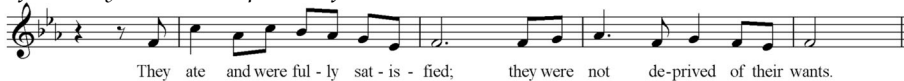

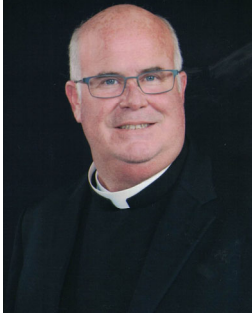

Pastor's Corner



ACTS Welcome Back

Although I am not able to be there in person, we certainly welcome back the women who participated in St. Pius X's ACTS

retreat this weekend! And many thanks to the women on the team for the gift they have given to the retreatants!

For those of you who don't know, the ACTS Retreat ("Adoration, Community, Theology, and Service") is an opportunity for us to deepen our commitment to discipleship in a concrete way which is evident in the way we live our lives individually, in the family, and in the parish community. The retreats are coordinated and led by our own parishioners. Let's continue to pray for these retreatants, as well as prospective and past retreatants, for a renewal of faith and deepened discipleship in Christ. In addition, there is a Men's ACTS Retreat from May 12-15, 2022. For those who have not yet made one, attending an ACTS Retreat would be a wonderful prayer commitment during Lent and beyond.

Pilgrimage

As most of you know, a group from our parish has been on pilgrimage to Portugal, Spain and France for the last 10

days. In all, the group is about 25 in number. The pilgrimage was postponed once due to the pandemic, so our anticipation for the trip has been in the making for two years. The pilgrimage is being coordinated by Magnificat Travel, and we thank them for making all the arrangements, especially the extra hoops we have to jump through in order to travel during the pandemic. At the time you are reading this, we are either in Lourdes, France preparing to come home or are on our way home. Know that we have been praying for you during the pilgrimage and we thank those who have been praying for us!

I would love to tell you about how the trip is going, but at the time of this writing we haven't left yet (publishing deadline and all). However, the highlights of the trip are visits to Fatima, Portugal (along with two Masses in the Apparition Chapel, where Our Lady appeared to three children in 1917 and the Miracle of the Sun took place). We will also visit Avila, Spain (St. John of the Cross and St. Theresa of Avila); Compostela de Santiago, Spain (Shrine of St. James, my patron "James, The Greater," of course); Loyola, Spain (St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuits); and Lourdes, France (where Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette and is known for many healing miracles).

As pastor, one of my duties is to pro-

vide to the congregation opportunities to make pilgrimages, and we hope to provide you more opportunities in the future. Although the form of pilgrimages has varied throughout the centuries, the core purpose has remained the same. Pilgrimages help us to strengthen our devotion to Christ by visiting places where He has been, where saints have been, or where actions or events attributable to God or other significant spiritual events have taken place. Collectively, we call these "Holy Sites." Visiting holy sites helps to strengthen our faith when we see the actual places where these things took place and can walk in the "footprint" of Jesus and the saints who have lived before us. When we learn about these events or the holy lives of the saints, and experience the actual visit to the sites, we cannot help but have our faith strengthened by the concrete reality we see with our eyes. The hope is that we are inspired to strengthen our relationship with God and have a renewed zeal and focus on our spiritual life. Please pray that all of our pilgrims have such an experience, that we all return safely home, and that through the renewal of our faith and the gift of God's Grace we can give Him greater glory in the good lives that we lead.

I look forward to seeing you next weekend, and may God keep you safe until then.

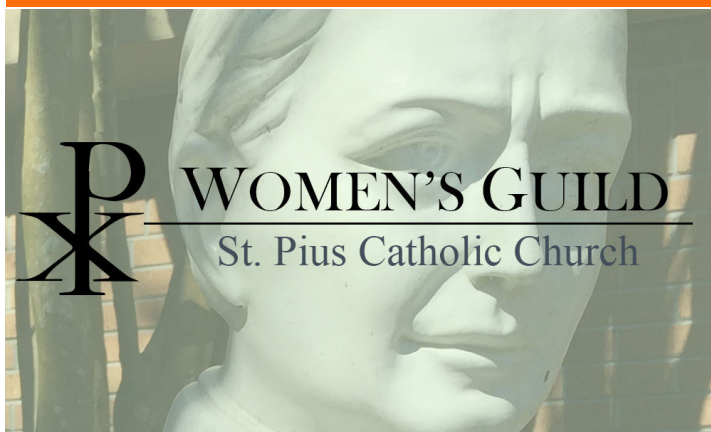
Tax Statements

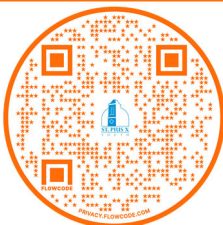

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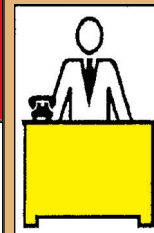
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
