Vocations: God is calling.

Our first vocation is the universal call to holiness. Every human person is called to live a life of holiness. Our secondary calling is one you might think of when you hear the word 'vocation': priesthood, religious life, married life, single life. This month, let's explore how God is calling us to grow in holiness through our vocations.

Join priests and religious around the world in praying the Liturgy of the Hours for at least one day.

Make a 'Thank You' card to send to your parish priest or religious sisters in your community.

Pray a prayer for vocations daily with your family.

Send a card to one of our seminarians.

Offer one Our Father prayer when you wake up for the intentions of your parish priest.

Complete a scavenger hunt: See if you can find anyone in your family history who was a priest or religious sister or brother. If not in your own family, how about in your parish community?

Pray for an increase in vocations, including those to the married life.

During a meal this month, instead of asking your kids what *they* want to be, ask them what *God* wants them to do/be when they grow up.
