


Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Third Sunday of Advent December 17, 2023 From Deacon Gill



We move again in Isaiah toward the end of the book. Last week's reading talked about heralding the coming of the Lord. This week, the reading is about the herald. As in keeping with the later parts of Isaiah, this is somewhat less joyful than the 'return of the captives' passage last week. The herald is sent to the poor, the brokenhearted, the captive and prisoners. These all are us. The messenger of God is sent to the places we have that are dark or hidden. He announces a year of favor, a time when the Lord comes to resolve and heal us from or sorrows and to free us from our bonds.

The herald knows that he is proclaiming the word of the Lord. He rejoices in it. He knows that his words will yield justice and praise because the word of the Lord is the power of the Lord. We are the herald. By our lives expressing His words, we proclaim glad tidings and justice, and praise springs up before all.

Saint Nicholas

Possibly the real-life inspiration for the beloved Christmas character of Santa Claus, Saint Nicholas is



not just the patron saint of children.

Saint Nicholas of Myra (c 270 – 343), also known as Nicholas of Bari, was an early Christian bishop of Greek descent from modern-day Demre, Turkey during the time of the Roman Empire. Because of the many miracles attributed to his intercession, he is also known as Nicholas the Wonderworker. Although his protection of and generosity to children were his standout traits, Saint Nicholas is also the patron saint of sailors, students, merchants, archers, repentant thieves, brewers, pawnbrokers, and the unmarried in various parts of the world. His legendary habit of secret gift-giving gave rise to the traditional model of Santa Claus ("Saint Nick") through the legendary Dutch figure of Sinterklaas.


