**Fourth Sunday of Advent**

December 24, 2023

From Deacon Gill

For this fourth week of Advent, we leave the Book of Isaiah. Our reading comes from the second Book of Samuel. Our reading is the establishment of the Davidic Covenant. The Davidic Covenant is the covenant between God and David and all of us that the messiah will be a descendant of King David.

Israel had been surrounded by hostile nations from the time they returned during the Exodus, the time of the judges, until the time of David. During David's time and under his command, Israel found a time of peace. David was secure and his thoughts turned away from the immediate to the eternal. The tent which held the Ark of God was the place that Moses went to talk with God. It was David's desire to provide a place for God that would be a permanent house.

God's response was that David would not build a permanent house for God. God would build a permanent house of David. A son of David, sprung from his loins, a member of David's house, would not only be king but *The King*, whose kingdom would endure forever. Not a King like any known on earth before. A King to forever rule over all their kingdoms of earth and their princes. When we as people eventually left kings behind, he would be a Lord over all the nations no matter what kind and, always, a son of David.

As we celebrate the birth of Christ this Christmas, let joy be born in our hearts not just this year but the whole year and our whole lives. Let us inspire this world that can seem so lost in darkness with the light of Christ in the light of our joy. Let us welcome family and friends. Let the light of Christ into your lives and into your hearts that your hearts may grow "three sizes" this day and return to the joy of celebrating the Eucharist today and every week of the year.

My thanks to all of you who have been faithful parishioners, for all you do even through the tough times. It is with humble joy that we give thanks for the honor of serving as your Pastor. Thank you for all your support and prayers. "Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find an infant wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger.' And suddenly there was a multitude of the heavenly host with the angel praising God and saying: 'Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests.'" (Luke 2:10-14)

There are so many people who made this Christmas look joyful and festive in our Parish, and to every single person who has helped I thank you from the bottom of my heart!

May your hearts be filled with the Joy of Christ's birth and may you be missionaries of that joy, Amen. Merry Christmas to you and to all your loved ones!

As we start each new year, we often make resolutions about diet and other material concerns. This year, may our resolutions include faithful attendance at Mass, to be more Christ-like and have a true heart for the less fortunate.

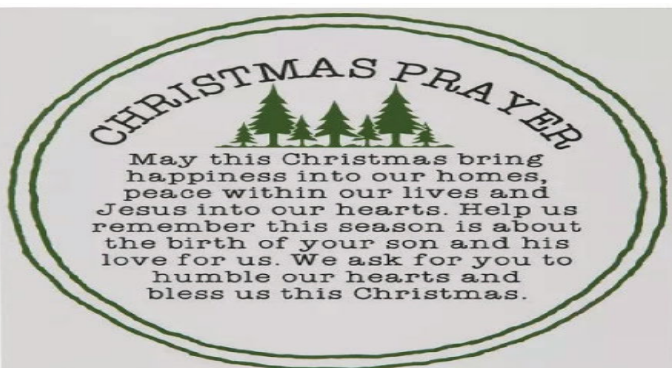

A HUGE THANK YOU!

On behalf of the homeless brothers and sisters who stayed the nights at St. Teresa of Avila in November, Night Off The Streets (N.O.T.S.) thanks you for your support and caring of 'these least brothers of mine'. Without your support we could not have shared a warm space for those living on the streets of Carson City this past November.

We served 105 individuals totaling 909 beds of which 694 were male and 215 were female. We averaged 30 guests per night. With our support and referrals, three guests found fulltime jobs, four found permanent housing, two were reunited with family. Twenty-nine guests received new coats. Over 100 pairs of socks were given out and sixteen handwarmers plus many winter gloves. Two guests were helped to apply for Social Security and State identification cards, which are crucial for applying for jobs and other services.

Now we move on to First Presbyterian Church of Carson City for December. Please keep the homeless and N.O.T.S. volunteers in your prayers.

Thank you, and may God bless you for your support and all you do to help those in need in our community.

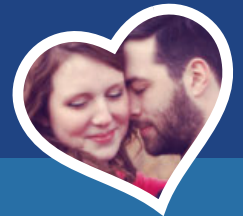
