

January 1 Solemnity

As you may know, January 1st is normally a Holy Day of Obligation which requires Catholics to attend Mass on the Solemnity.

However, in 1993 the US Bishops, in accord with the Holy See, formally abrogated the obligation to attend Mass on this Solemnity when January 1st falls on a Saturday or a Monday (as it does this year).

Therefore, January 1st remains a Solemnity but the faithful are not obligated to attend Mass. We will be having our regular Mass at 8 am.
