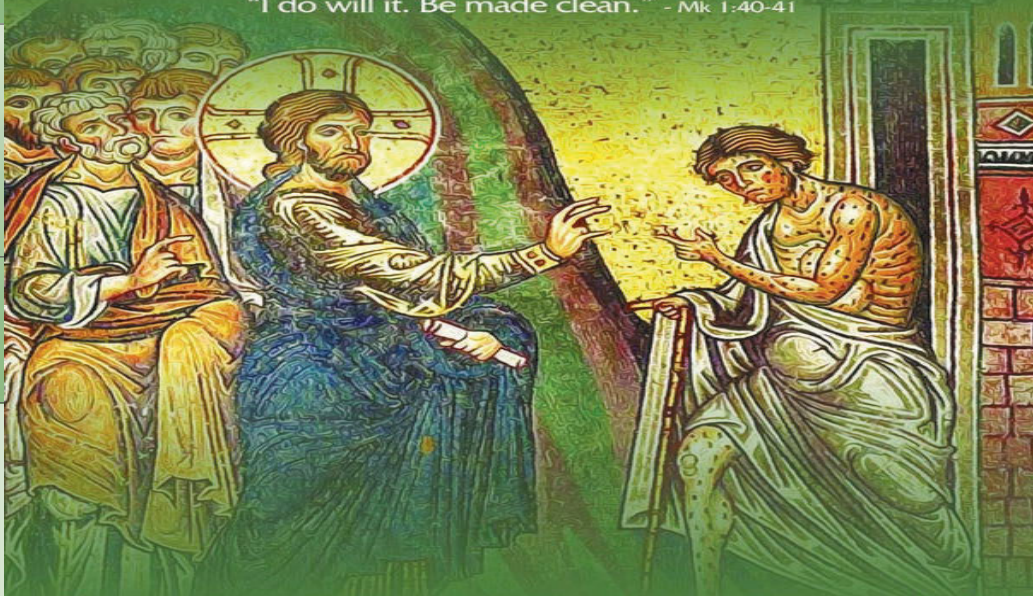

Inspired by Jesus' example, may we be agents of healing and inclusion in our communities, extending love and compassion to all, especially those society may consider outcasts.
