The glory of the risen Lord has permeated all of creation. He is the Lord of Heaven and Earth. This Ascension Feast is a feast of Glory: the result of Jesus self-giving life and death on the cross for our salvation. But this glory does not just belong to Jesus, he wants to share it with us. For that reason, he promises to send his followers the Holy Spirit as he ascends to his glory, not to abandon us, but to accompany us through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Spirit of God empowers us in so many ways: through a deeper wisdom and understanding of the world around us, through the courage to speak and act in conformity to our faith while the world does not always embrace the Spirit's guidance, and by mediating the very real and sacramental presence of the Lord Jesus in his Word, through the Eucharist and the other sacraments, and so, in and through us! This is the consequence and the

great commission that Easter blesses us with: We are transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit into a missionary church: a people created to share in the glory of the Risen Jesus and commissioned to enable others to share in that same glory with us!

This week: Practice the ancient prayer pattern of the novena: a prayer said for nine days that leads up to Pentecost! The nine days of prayer leading from the Ascension to the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles at Pentecost is the first and greatest novena! Find your “upper room”: a quiet place in your home or in creation and spend some time in prayer: (Acts1:14). Invite family members and friends to pray with you. Post this prayer on your social media!

Pentecost Novena: prayed on all the days between the Ascension of the Lord and Pentecost:



Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you will renew the face of the earth.

You have taught the hearts of your faithful, In the same Spirit Help us to relish what is right and always rejoice in your consolation.

Adult Faith Formation: Spring Series

The Church celebrates several major feasts during the months of May and June during the Sunday Liturgies. In preparation for these feasts we invite you to a prayerful, scriptural reflection and dialogue on these themes:

The Gift and Fruits of the Holy Spirit

On Sunday, May 28, we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost. The descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-11) was the moment when the Church was specifically endowed with power by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The manifestations of the Holy Spirit's gifts were not in doubt and were perceptible (1 Corinthians 12-14). Christians receive these gifts at Baptism and they are renewed at Confirmation Therefore, They are within each person who has received these sacraments. The Church is the Body of Christ and within the Church there are different gifts, but every one of them is a gift of the same Holy Spirit. This prayerful reflection and dialogue will be a way to prepare for our celebration of Pentecost by praying that the gifts of the Holy Spirit that are already within us, will be stirred into flame and become manifest in our personal lives and in our life in the Church.

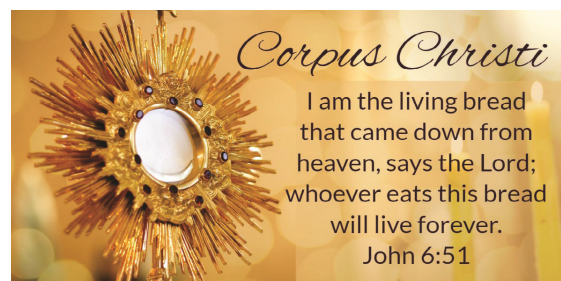

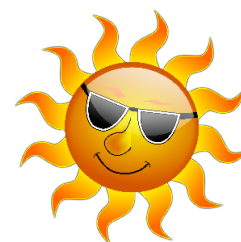
