From the Director of Discipleship Formation

Do you make the Sign of the Cross in your prayer?

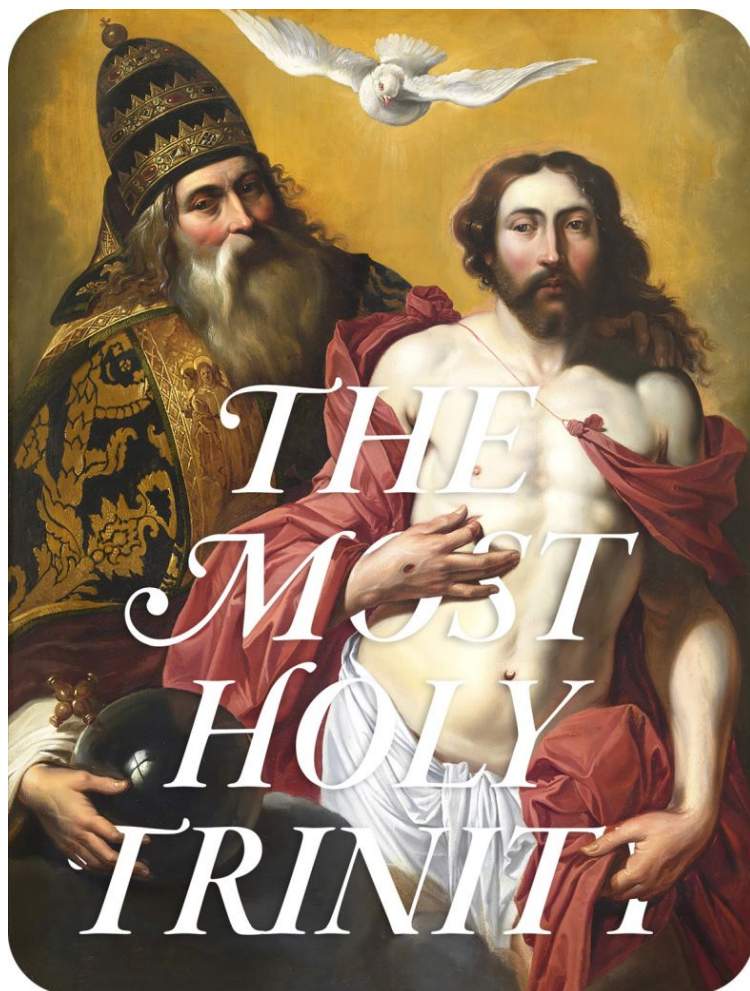
This mark of our faith is a prayer in itself as it professes our belief in the Holy Trinity. This marking of ourselves in this way goes back to the Old Testament. The prophet Ezekiel (Ez 9:1-7) has a vision where he sees sins committed by God's people. Those who lamented their sins and changed their ways were marked with an "X" on their forehead. This mark would spare them from divine judgment.

In our baptism, the sign of the cross is traced on our foreheads as the priest/deacon says, "The Church of God receives you with great joy. In her name I sign you with the Sign of the Cross of Christ our Savior." This Sign of the Cross is the beginning of a relationship of love. From then on, each baptized follower of Christ prays with this gesture, recalling his/her baptism as well as the relationship of love between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The Scriptures on this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity reveal to us that the three divine persons of the Trinity cannot be understood apart from their unity. The relationship with God that we initiate in our baptism also enters into relationship with all that God does. In our initiation into this reality, we no longer exist in isolation but are part of the body of Christ, with the Trinitarian God as the Head of the body.

Let us recognize the work of the Holy Spirit in each of us, building up the Body of Christ as we affirm this truth of our faith.

Feast of Corpus Christi

Sunday, June 11

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also called Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ celebrates the real presence of the body (corpus) of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. We will celebrate Corpus Christi on Sunday, June 11. The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic faith to process the Real Presence of Jesus — the Eucharist — in public. After the 11:00 Mass, we will process with the monstrance to St. Anne Chapel while singing Eucharistic songs and hymns. Please join in this most holy of celebrations.

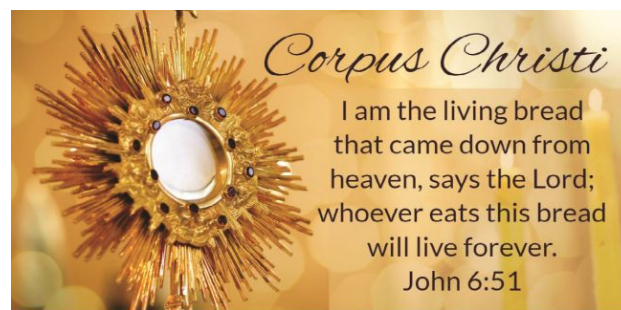

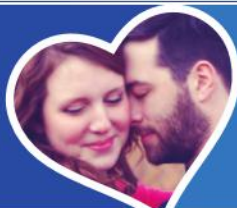
