When we listen to the gospel today, we hear Jesus speak of fear. He seems to be encouraging us to be brave in the proclamation of the Gospel.

"What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light". At first glance, today's instructions seem to address fear. But a close look, particularly when the verses are read in context with the teachings as a whole, reveal that Jesus is addressing the subject of attachments, allegiances and their relationship to

discipleship. Concisely, fear, in the negative sense, is an attachment we are instructed to disengage from. If we desire to be faithful disciples; fear in the positive sense, as in allegiance to God, must be practiced and is required for discipleship.

To be attached to our possessions, our image, our reputation, or even our life inhibits our ability to be faithful disciples. Fear prevents proclamation. As disciples of Jesus, we are called to proclaim his

teachings to announce that he is the Messiah. In the present day, this call to discipleship may seem a bit unnecessary, since it has become commonplace to claim that one is Christian. But Jesus did not instruct us simply to say that we are Christian. Instead, he calls us to fear in the positive sense, when we align ourselves with God.

Allegiance to God demands that we declare our faith with our voice and our actions. To truly follow such a charge is difficult because it requires us to remain

faithful to God over and against anything or anyone that commands our time and devotion and distracts us from our duty as disciples. Yet Jesus tells us that if we remain steadfast, he will *“acknowledge us before the Father who is in heaven”*.

When you pray the Our Father this week, allow your fear to dissipate, and instead draw deeply on the trust in God your creator, that lies deep in your heart. When we grow in this kind of trust, it is reflected in our lives!

Go Make of All Disciples

From the Director of Discipleship Formation

Do you know how many Psalms there are?

In the Old Testament, there are 150 Psalms. These divinely inspired hymns or poems are given to us by God, primarily through David. There are different themes in the Psalms like praise, sorrow, petition, thanksgiving, judgement, history of God's care over Israel. There's really something for everyone in the Psalms! Where do we experience the use of Psalms in the Church today? Most commonly, as a response to God's Word during the Liturgy of the Word, a Psalm is prayed after the First Reading at Mass. Psalms are also used in the Liturgy of the Hours, which gives up to 7 different sets of Psalms and readings for different hours of prayer during the day. Morning and Evening Prayer are the most common.

Why am I telling you this now? People often don't know how to pray - praying the Psalms is a great way to model prayer to God. There are simple prayers and extravagant ones as well in the Psalms. For example, Psalm 117 is a simple prayer of praise to God that is only a couple sentences long. Another short prayer is from the Responsorial Psalm from today's Liturgy of the Word: "Lord, in your great love, answer me" (Psalm 69). Now, that doesn't mean that whatever we ask of God, we get. But, we are encouraged to pray to God for all things, and God will answer us in the way He knows best!

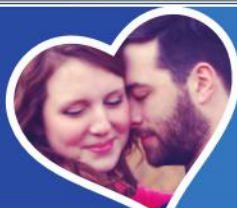
