15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
JULY 16, 2023

Summer is a time of transition for priests in the Archdiocese of Detroit. Each spring the bishops and priests discern together the needs of parishes, and the charisms of priests, so that both parish and priest can flourish.

In our own family, this process has led to two changes, which I wanted to share with you.

1. Fr. John Herman, a Holy Cross priest who has pastored a parish in Mexico, and worked forming priests at the University of Notre Dame came home to Trenton earlier this year. Fr. John has applied for incardination, a process through which a religious order priest becomes an Archdiocesan priest. He spent the first seven months with us in Trenton, helping out at St. Joseph and at other parishes. Now, as a part of the incardination process, he has been assigned to St. Anne parish, whose church

recently became a basilica. There he will be able to minister to Spanish speaking parishioners, among others. If you have a chance to visit St. Anne, which is the oldest parish in the Archdiocese, I'm sure Fr. John would be happy to see you.

2. Fr. Greg Banazak is a priest of the Archdiocese of Detroit. I met Fr. Greg when we were both in College in the mid 1980's at Sacred Heart Seminary. Fr. Greg's ministry has been principally as a professor of Theology and Academic Dean at SS Cyril and Methodius Seminary in Orchard Lake, MI. That Seminary closed recently, and Fr. Greg has been assigned to our Family of Parishes. I know Fr. Greg to be a wise and caring man and I'm looking forward to ministering along side of him in our Family of Parishes. Fr. Banazak will be the pastor in solidum at St. Timothy parish in Trenton.

I've included the formal announcements of these assignments below. Please keep both Fr. Greg and Fr. John in your prayers. Pray for all priests, and for vocations to the priesthood, religious life and Lay Ecclesial Ministry. We are all so happy to serve you as priests. I hope more people can learn to embrace and the enjoy the blessing the ministry can be in their lives!

Reverend John Herman, C.S.C., with the concurrence of his Provincial Superior, Very Reverend William Lies, C.S.C., appointed a member of the In Solidum team of priests who will pastor Holy Cross (Hungarian) Parish, Detroit; Most Holy Trinity Parish, Detroit; Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish, Detroit; Basilica of St. Anne Parish, Detroit; St. Francis d'Assisi-St. Hedwig Parish, Detroit; that form Southwest Detroit Family of Parishes, effective July 1, 2023. Father Herman will live and serve at St. Anne Parish, Detroit, under the mentorship of Monsignor Charles Kosanke. Father Herman has begun the process of incardination ad experimentum in the Archdiocese of Detroit.

Reverend Gregory Banazak appointed a member of the In Solidum team of priests who pastor St. Timothy Parish, Trenton; St. Roch Parish, Flat Rock; St. Joseph Parish, Trenton; St. Cyprian Parish, Riverview; Sacred Heart Parish, Grosse Ile; Our Lady of the Woods Parish, Woodhaven, that form Downriver Missionaries for Christ Family of Parishes, effective August 1, 2023. Father Banazak will live and serve primarily at St. Timothy Parish, Trenton. Father Banazak previously served on faculty at SS. Cyril and Methodius Seminary.

From the Director of Discipleship Formation

Why do people have to suffer?

This is an age-old question that is very difficult to answer, especially in the midst of people's suffering. When I am in a situation with a person, or a family in the hospital, they sometimes ask, "Why is God letting this happen?" The Second Reading at today's Mass on this 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time gives us St. Paul's response to suffering (Romans 8:18-23). "I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us." St. Paul begins this teaching by connecting our sufferings to the glory that will be revealed to us. This revelation comes with our own death, when we see the face of God, the beatific vision. That is the time when we will all share in the glorious freedom of the children of God.

The glory we as Christians are destined to share with Christ far exceeds any suffering in our present lives. Patient endurance is the medicine to human suffering. I know for many, that's a big pill to swallow (sorry for the pun!), but our plans don't always align with God's plans. A little further in Romans 8, St. Paul writes, "We know that all things work for good for those who love God" (Romans 8:28). In difficult times, in times of suffering, I think our best approach is to be patient, pray, and love God.

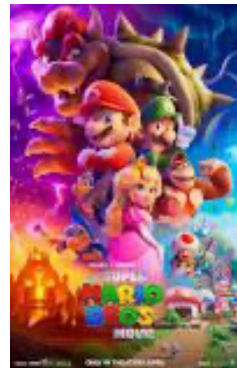
