In these beautiful weeks of summer we have been blessed on Sundays with the parables of creation: planting, and harvesting, and stories of growth and new life. A little bit of "seeing the forest for the trees" can help us to deepen our encounter with the Word of God in these weeks. The parables we hear from the 13th chapter of Matthew's gospel (Mt 13: 1-52) are part of a section he designed, which we now refer to as the parables discourse. There are no fewer than seven parables in this section! These parables deal with the lack of response, and even hostility that Jesus encountered in their original context of everyday Palestinian life. This is a reality that gospel has always encountered, even to this day.

The response to the indifference to the proclamation of the Gospel that is outlined in these parables of Jesus is one of reassurance and patience rather than judgement or condemnation. The reassurance comes from the promise of God's Word that Scripture reveals God's will to save His people through Jesus the Messiah, the teller of parables. Secondly, patience is encouraged in these parables which so often use agricultural imagery

common in the life of second century Palestine, there is the promise of a harvest, of a completion, when the fullness of God's Kingdom will prevail.

This week, as you weed, garden, golf, walk in the woods, or bike through your neighborhood, or travel up North, keep your eyes and your heart open to the glory of God reflected in his creation this summer season. Don't hesitate to point out God's glory to those with whom you enjoy these summer days. Creation is a parable that reassures us of God's love as well!

Don't forget that we have a "last chance" mass every Sunday evening at 5 PM at Sacred Heart, Grosse IIe. During the summer months of June-August this liturgy is celebrated on E. River Rd, on the Detroit River, outdoors, weather permitting, or in the air-conditioned comfort of St. Anne Chapel. You are always welcome to join us.

May God continue to bless your summer with his surprising and grace filled presence.






